My1ST Home

The My1stHome grant is awarded to select first-time homebuyers in an effort to enhance the success of homebuyers in maintaining homeownership.

To qualify, applicants must purchase a home for no more than \$230,000. Use the services of a REALTOR® to complete the closing of the property. Complete an approved homebuyer education through a REACH (Readiness Education Awareness Collaborative for Homebuyers) affiliate or online education approved by NIFA.

Applicants can request the grant applications through their REACH or N.I.F.A affiliates upon completion of the required education, or online at HomeBuyersAssistanceFoundation.com.
