- A race team consists of 5 people, 14 years or older. No substitutes, all riders must be registered.
- One member of the team is the rider and is responsible for completing the activities at each station.
- In order to qualify for finishing the race, at least four or five team members must cross the finish line in contact with the bed and three members must also be in contact with the ground when crossing the finish line.
- For safety reasons, all bed and three members must also be in contact with the ground when crossing the finish line.
- For safety reasons, all bed riders must wear a safety helmet. You may bring your own (bike helmet is sufficient) or one will be provided to you. It is suggested that pushers also wear a safety helmet.
- Please feel free to dress up (costumes, uniforms, etc.)
