Updated Restore Illinois Plan

The Governor's updated <u>Restore Illinois Plan</u> now has 11 regions and a <u>new series of metrics</u> that could trigger mitigation measures.

<u>Downstate "Metro East" region</u> hits 'warning' level of days with increases in coronavirus positivity rate. Region 4 has seen an increase in test positivity rates for seven over the past 10 days, hitting the "warning" level outlined in the updated "Restore Illinois" plan. Moreover, the region's rate was at 7.1 percent as of July 17 and is approaching 8 percent, the point at which Governor JB Pritzker previously said reopening measures would likely be rolled back as part of a "failsafe" if cases exceed that level for three days. The region includes Bond, Clinton, Madison, Monroe, Randolph, St. Clair and Washington counties.
