



Tier 3 Mitigations Lifted, Springfield and Sangamon County Return to Phase 4

Yesterday afternoon the <u>Illinois Department of Public Health</u> (IDPH) announced that Region 3, which includes Springfield and Sangamon County, has officially returned to the less restrictive Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois Plan. Our region has been in the more highly restrictive Tier 3 mitigations since November 20, 2020.

Among other things, the move back to Phase 4 allows restaurants and bars to provide indoor service with capacity limits and IDPH approved safety guidance. Meetings and gatherings of the lesser of 50 people or 50% of room capacity are also allowed again. This limit is subject to change based on the latest data and guidance.
