2024 LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

HOW THE AGC OF UTAH REPRESENTED THE INDUSTRY THROUGHOUT THIS YEAR'S SESSION

➤➤➤ A RECORD BREAKING YEAR

During the 2024 Utah Legislative session, legislature passed a record-breaking 591 bills. This year Utah leaders passed a record \$29.4 billion budget for fiscal year 2025 which starts July 1st.

The Associated General Contractors (AGC) of Utah proudly embraces its role as "The Voice of Utah's Construction Future." Representing commercial contractors, subcontractors, and service/suppliers statewide is a responsibility that the AGC holds in high regard.

Throughout the past year the AGC has been diligently monitoring and actively engaged in nearly 65 pieces of legislation. This commitment to legislative involvement underscores the association's dedication to advocating for policies that promote a vibrant and thriving construction industry in Utah.

This year's legislative session has yielded significant developments with profound implications for the Construction, Architecture, and Engineering (CAE) community. Throughout the session, a record number of bills were passed, addressing a wide range of issues pertinent to our industry.

During the UDOT presentation, Carlos Braceras, UDOT's Executive Director, discussed funding for the upcoming year.



DFCM OUTLOOK UTAH FAIRPARK AREA INVESTMENT



One of the major topics of discussion this year with the passing of H.B. 562 is the Utah Fairpark area investment and redevelopment district.

DFCM discussed that this will allow for the creation of the Utah State Fairpark Authority and has an intent to engage in a private Public Partnership with the Miller Company announcing that it will invest at least \$3.5 billion in funding for the project. An additional \$1 billion will be funded by the state.




