
#### CRITERIA TO BE CONSIDERED FOR RECOGNITION:

To be nominated, the candidate (living or deceased) must be/have:

- 1. A graduate of Tomah High School or attended Tomah High School for t least two years.
- 2. A Tomah High School Alumni of at least ten years prior to nomination.
