What is CCYL?

Clinton Chamber Youth Leadership (CCYL) is a high school leadership program challenging students to "take charge" of their lives while giving back to their community. Led by experts, sessions include learning about leadership styles, business etiquette, history of Clinton, and entrepreneurship.

Who can join CCYL?
