Executive Director's Report

This past year has been one of challenges, new commitments, excitement and growth for CCID.

The year began with uncertainty, as the consortium found itself searching for a new home base from which to operate. The leadership changes at Brevard Community College also presented us with special challenges. For the first time in our twenty-two year history CCID found itself with a new chairperson.

The retirement of **Dr. Maxwell King** was a seminal event in the history of CCID. He had provided leadership for the organization throughout its years, and his departure was not anticipated. Max will be remembered by everyone as a great leader, a great internationalist, and a great educator. He will also be known throughout the community college world as a college president unafraid of accepting the challenge of international work, and committing college staff to working overseas. He pioneered this at a time when community colleges did not venture far from home.

Because of these changed circumstances, the Board of Directors established an RFP process, and three colleges applied to host the consortium. Daytona Beach Community College, Florida; St. Petersburg Community College, Florida; and Kirkwood Community College, Iowa, submitted applications. At the July Board Meeting held at Toronto, Canada, by unanimous vote the Board agreed that Kirkwood Community College would be the host institution. In addition, it was agreed that the chair person would not be based at the host institution.

The summer and early autumn were occupied by the move of the office, its functions, files and equipment to Iowa. As the new Executive Director, the job of learning in rapid order the intricacies of the various projects, activities, conferences and meetings, as well as the personalities of the board members was the immediate challenge.

At the summer workshop in Toronto, the Board and the International Education Directors went through a process of goal setting. The following broad priorities were established:

- Establishing a Strategic Plan
- Ensure Financial Viability
- Become a Primary Contractor
- Provide Leadership and Services
- Provide opportunities to partner worldwide
- Position CCID as primary community college international development organization
- Increase sponsors at Annual Conference
- Ensure that members are active CCID participants
- Develop advance conference agenda
- Increase conference participation

With the assistance of the previous executive director, Bob Ludwiczak, the transition was smooth, as was the **Annual Conference** at Huntington Beach, CA. It was rewarding to hear it said that the conference was one of the best ever, with over 200 people in attendance. One change in the conference organization was the hiring of MRA Services to co-ordinate the Exhibitor / Vendor Program. We can expect to see many more vendors at Annual Conferences in the future. The Annual Conference is the show piece activity of CCID, where we reach out to introduce ourselves to others, as well as provide activities for the Members and Affiliates. At the **Summer Workshop**, a new initiative will be the provision of a forum for Member and Affiliate Colleges to visit about projects and activities.

Another activity has been almost monthly visits to Washington DC. Contacting, developing, and building relationships with potential partners has been a high priority. One of the goals from the planning meeting in Toronto was to establish CCID as an organization with financial strength. In reviewing how that might be reached, gaining major projects was an obvious goal. Hence the networking in Washington. CCID is now registered with the **Asia Development Bank**, with the **Africa Bank**, the **Inter American Bank** and the **World Bank**.

During the past year CCID has received **official delegations** from Trinidad and Tobago, Guyana, the Ukraine, Mexico, and China.

The **International Education Directors** met three times during the year. The July meeting took place at the Summer Workshop in Toronto, Canada; the January meeting at the Annual Meeting in Huntington Beach, California; and in April they met at Nashville, Tennessee. In addition a group of six met in Washington DC in early January for a workshop on how CCID can position itself to bid for major projects, such as World Bank. A shortened version on the same topic will be presented to the Presidents and IED's at the Summer Workshop. Due to the changes which the corporation has experienced, there were many issues for the IED's to address, including broad goals and objectives for the Corporation, revision of the Operational Manual, development of a Mission Statement, determining which areas of the world on which to focus activities, and others.

CCID was represented by at least three presentations at the **AACC Convention in Nashville**, at the **First World Congress of Colleges and Polytechnics in Quebec**, and at a number of state wide meetings sponsored by the **Stanley Foundation**. CCID was invited to cosponsor these meetings, initiated by the Foundation. We now have a table top display, so the CCID presence at conferences can be more visible.

With ACIIE and the Stanley Foundation, CCID was a partner in organizing a hearing in Washington DC on the international component of the *New Expeditions* project. The afternoon of testimony in the House Banking Committee Room, was followed by a two day retreat, funded by the Stanley Foundation, at Airlee House. The findings resulting from the testimony and the retreat have been presented to Robert Atwell for inclusion in the *New Expeditions Report: Community Colleges in the Year 2010*.

A University of Iowa Ph.D. candidate interned with CCID for six months and undertook vital background work on behalf of the consortium. Ms. Tina McRee researched **NICRA** for us and established an indirect cost rate for CCID grant applications. She researched appropriate **foundations** to approach for institutional capacity building for the organization. She sorted and collated resumes and C.V.'s for the **CCID Data Base of Consultants**. She attended meetings

and prepared papers, and in turn provided a sounding board for the Executive Director during this challenging time.

Robert Keener and Sinclair Community College continue to provide outstanding service to CCID by editing and printing the **CCID Newsletter** four times annually.

The IED's assisted with the effort to produce a comprehensive and professional **Capabilities Statement**. The initiative was spearheaded by State Center Community College District and Sinclair Community College. The result is a highly regarded document that can be added to and expanded as new projects come on line.

The **CCID Website** was moved from Brevard to Kirkwood Community College. Additions to the site include on-line conference and workshop registration; the **Corporate Profile**; **Recent CCID Projects**; and **Exemplary International Programs**. The marketing of CCID took a new turn with the introduction of this latter initiative. A flier has been distributed nationwide and is resulting in colleges being able to showcase their international programs through CCID. Those having papers published will be able to present at the annual conference, and will also be posted on the CCID website.

Grants, Contracts, Training and Proposals

The \$1.4 million **UDLP/CCID/Guyana** project (managed by St.Louis Community College) came to a conclusion, and the final evaluation took place in November. The outstanding success of this project was evidenced by the meeting in the office of the US Ambassador to Guyana, when the Ambassador made it very clear how much the project had achieved. The Minister for Education, Dr. Dale Bisnuth, also indicated the success of the project by repeatedly referencing it in speeches and commentaries. Other Guyana projects in the planning stages, include **Workforce Development Planning** with a proposal with the US Institute for Peace; a **Measurement, Evaluation and Research Project**, an IDB project; and a proposal to **upgrade Secondary School Laboratories**. The \$750,000.00 **Universidad Don Bosco** Project, in El Salvador also concluded this year.

CCID is discussing with the **Organization of American States** to how we might assist Honduras and Nicaragua in coping with the aftermath of Hurricane Mitch. In **Trinidad and Tobago**, CCID is working with the National Institute for Higher Education and Research (NIHERST), on devising a strategy for the creating a National Community College (NCC). Various attachments have taken place during the year, with CCID consultants going to the islands. The Minister of Information, Communications, Training and Distance Education, **Trinidad and Tobago**, visited with CCID and has requested that we work with them on a distance education conference in September 2000. Prior to that, other attachments to train teachers in distance education and curriculum will be taking place. CCID is discussing with American College Testing and National Computer Systems, the possibility of a collaborative project in **Guatemala**. An organization in **Argentina** has contacted CCID to determine our interest in collaborating with them in organizing and developing a community college.

In Asia, through a contact developed at APEC, CCID is following up on contacts in **Singapore** which are interested in the community college concept. A similar contact in the **Philippines** is also being developed. The **India Business Linkage Program** developed by Eastern Iowa Community College District is continuing to link small and medium sized businesses with

companies in India. Since becoming registered with the **Asia Development Bank (ADB)**, CCID is now able to bid on their projects, the first step of which is an Expression of Interest. CCID has an EOI for an ADB project in **Mongolia**. If short-listed CCID will be bidding the proposal against other development organizations. In **Vietnam**, the contacts established by Lansing Community College are bearing fruit with a University there requesting Lansing to assist with plans for a community college. The CCID/Spokane Agreement with the Oaska Colleges of Technology, **Japan**, continues to produce a high level of activity. With **Apec-Hurdit**, the CCID position as a US Delegate has begun to become productive, with a pre-proposal for workforce development training being developed.

Eastern Iowa Community College District's project in **South Africa** links business faculty with Vista University. CCID submitted a tender to the Government of **Botswana**, to conduct a TVET feasibility study for the Ministry of Education. We are discussing with an energy provider the possibility of providing training on their behalf in **Southern Africa**.

In Europe, CCID will be visiting the **Barents Sea Euro-Arctic Group** to develop activities from the joint signing of the Memorandum of Agreement at the 1999 Annual Conference. The MOU with the Barents Sea Consortium will provide opportunities for CCID colleges to work with northern Norway, northern Sweden, northern Finland and western Russia on cooperative activities.

CCID will be receiving a delegation from **Macedonia** during the summer, and anticipate that when hostilities in that region become less, that development activities will be needed. We are positioning ourselves to be a player in that arena.

In conjunction with the Futures Group International, CCID is part of a \$4.4 proposal to upgrade technical and vocational training in the **Lebanon**. The proposal is at the short listing stage.

In a new venture this year CCID began a jointly written proposal for funding from the **National Security Education Program (NSEP)**, focusing on acquiring languages. This will be submitted for the next round of grants in early spring year 2000. The countries of focus will be Russia, Brazil and Japan. This initiative was spearheaded by Irene Lietz at Lansing Community College, in conjunction with over ten other CCID members.

Other Consortial Activities.

CCID is developing a strategy with our Australian Member College, the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology to establish an **overseas office**. An India office is also a possibility.

Sinclair Community College took the initiative to lead a new effort in developing an ongoing series of **Professional Development Activities**. Beginning with a program to England in July 1999, other colleges are following with further professional development programs. Sinclair has agreed to coordinate these efforts on behalf of CCID.

CCID is in the process of organizing a **president's visit** to Niels Brock Business College, Copenhagen.

The **CCID Faculty Exchange Program** has been managed for the past year by Gary Plato at Waukesha Technical and Community College. This long standing program continues to provide

an excellent avenue for member and affiliate colleges to send and receive faculty. CCID continues to have authority through the **USIA Exchange Visitor Program** to issue IAP66's, thereby facilitating exchanges for scholars wishing to visit Member and Affiliate colleges.

New Directions

We continue to believe that the community college model has much to offer other countries. The willingness of CCID to adapt that model to local needs, continues to be a powerful selling point. The Executive offices will market this concept assertively over the coming year.

CCID will continue to build its capacity and base. We shall review foundation support, and we shall develop the overseas office concept. There are many advantages to having a base outside the US, and these need to be explored further. The role of member and affiliate colleges will need to be continuously evaluated, as new demands upon CCID make themselves felt.

Further efforts of the Executive Offices will be to focus on Washington DC, and developing the various funding opportunities available to the Consortium. CCID made very real headway in building relationships among the various agencies, and this needs to continue.

The focus on regions of the world will continue to develop. CCID has clusters of activities in the Caribbean, and in Asia, with other regions such as Africa and South America showing interest. We shall invest in the areas where we have worked in the past, but we shall also prospect in new areas.

We shall build a schedule of professional development activities around the world, and put it into a rolling 3 to 5 year program.

Faculty Exchanges will continue to be a high priority, as this is a major road by which colleges can be internationalized.

The world is rapidly changing, and despite the difficulties experience by CCID from the transition, the major impact has been to reinvigorate the organization. Today we are prepared for new initiatives and major projects as never before. We look forward to the new year and the challenges it presents.
