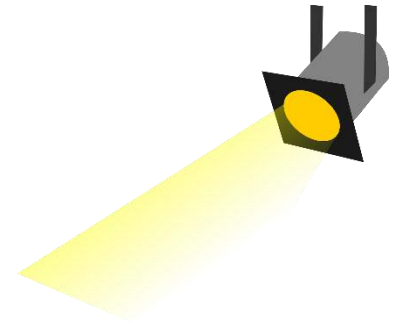

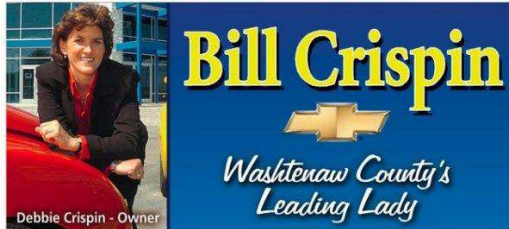
Bemis Farms Childcare & Preschool
