Background

- Chamber's Economic Development Committee identified a need for Sports Fields for Quality of Life Matters
- In March 2017 the Texas Parks and Wildlife Commission awarded a 50% - \$500,000 Grant to the City of Del Rio for the development of the following:
 - Develop hike and bike trail connections from the new sports park to existing parks in the area;
 - Renovate two existing practice baseball fields into competitive fields
 - Develop a new Babe Ruth Baseball field;
 - Develop concession stand and restroom facilities to support the fields;
 - Develop multi-purpose play fields;
 - Develop an all-inclusive, universally accessible play environment;
 - Development of picnic areas;
 - Development of new hike and bike trails in the Sports Park with access points to adjacent neighborhoods. This hike and bike trail is proposed to have fitness interpretive centers throughout the trail;
 - Development of gardens using native species and xeriscape techniques;

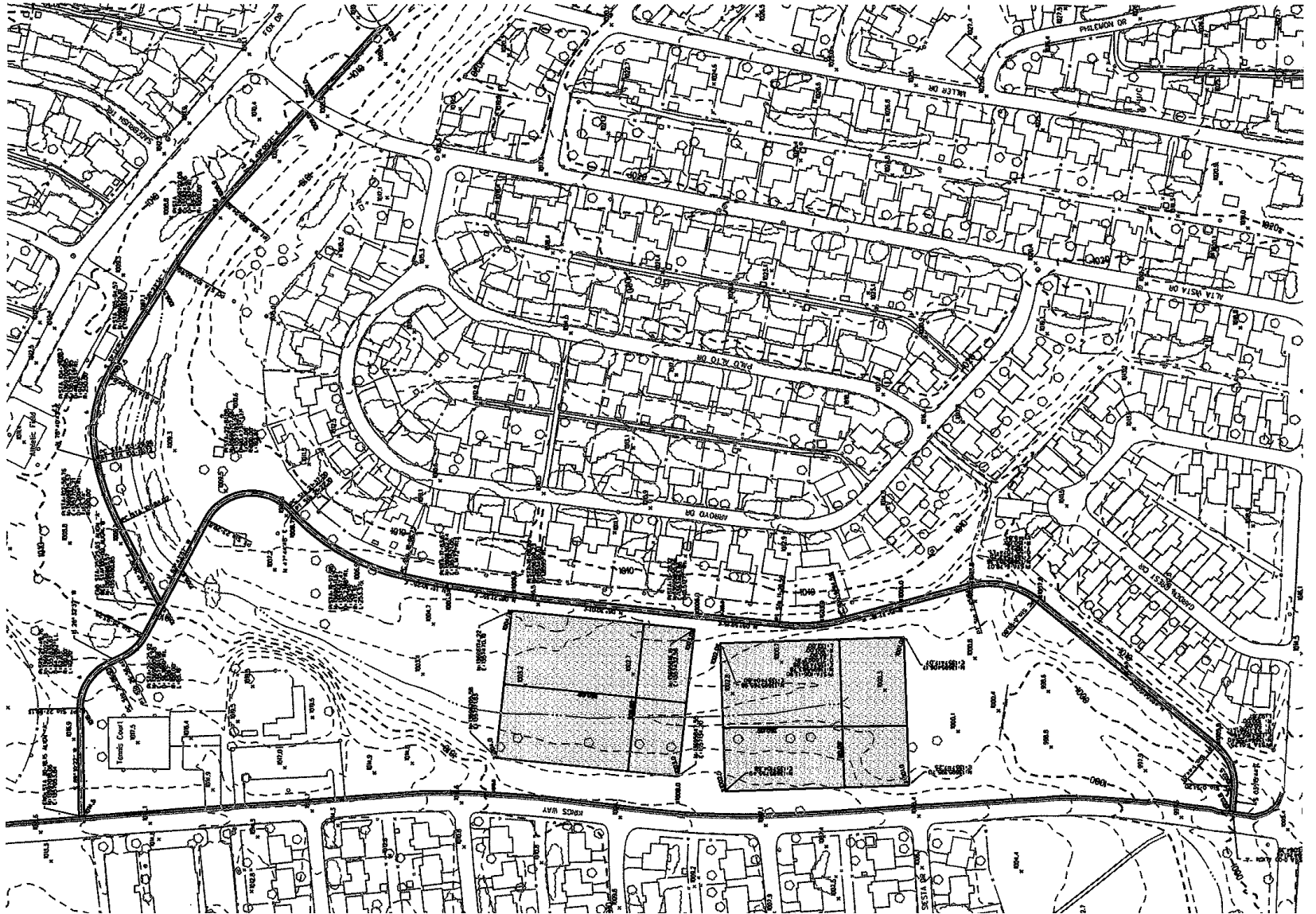
Project Location
