# 2023 RESEARCH REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

MWi released its research report on October 25, 2023, at the Research and Recognition Breakfast held at the University Club. The percentage of women on the boards of Wisconsin's Top 50 public companies continued to increase, reaching an all-time high, soaring past MWi's goal of 25% women directors by 2025.
