Nestled between lakes and reservoirs, amidst towering trees and rolling hills, resides a community endowed by nature and enriched with opportunity. Armonk, one of North Castle's three hamlets along with North White Plains and Banksville, is a mere 35 miles from New York City, yet a world apart. The convenience of nearby airports, trains and highways affords commuters the luxury of a suburban yet cultural retreat.

The Armonk business community includes one-of-a-kind merchants, top-quality service providers and a food scene both recognized and lauded by foodies everywhere. Multinational companies, including IBM and Swiss Re, are among the town's largest employers, with their tax dollars helping to support its quality of life.

The Byram Hills School District enrolls over 2,300 students throughout its four schools. One of the state's top districts, its programs and services are evidence of the community's involvement and support. Armonk's high-achieving schools provide both academic excellence and a pathway to the nation's best colleges and universities.

Schultz' Cider Mill: The Apple of Armonk's Eye

Long before Armonk was known for its apple cider and donuts, Edwin (Ed) Schultz had a plan. In the 1940's he worked as a machinist at the Tarrytown Chevy plant. Each fall, the factory closed down for retooling, and he was laid off. During those breaks, he often hunted wild game, sometimes in apple orchards. One lucky day, a farmer offered him all the apples in his orchard for a flat fee of \$25. And that is where the idea was born.

Ed's family (residents and proprietors in Valhalla) lived and worked near the Kensico Dam. They owned the Overlook Tavern, where Ed's mother Elizabeth set up a hot dog stand. Sensing an opportunity to supplement his income by selling apples to visitors from the city, Ed built a graduated display stand and began selling the apples outside the Tavern for \$.35 for a five pound basket. "He made enough money that fall to buy a car," reminisced Bud Schultz, Ed's son, and long-time Armonk resident.

During his travels in his new Chevy, Ed and his wife Mary saw a business opportunity in Armonk. When the banks wouldn't lend them the \$350 for a deposit on the land, they reached out to Mary's uncle. In 1951, that was enough for Ed. With help from his brother-in-law, Henry Kassen, he built the original cement block building. There, they sold watermelons, summer vegetables and the finest New York State apples, closing down each winter. In 1953, they added the larger building for which Bud remembers digging the foundation. It was on its way to becoming Schultz's Cider Mill and a Hudson Valley legend. What made the cider so great, says Bud, was that "we only used the apples directly from the trees and never from the ground, where they could get bruised."

In 1965, after the neighboring Log Cabin Restaurant burned down, they introduced their famous donuts to hungry visitors, who came from near and far to get a taste. Bud remembers when Mary was told by a baker to use only the finest flour and oil in their donut recipe. She insisted on using the same fine purveyor of these ingredients "from the day they started until the day they quit."

And even though the beloved Cider Mill closed its doors in 2002, the memories of steaming hot cider and donuts in the autumn and winter chill will forever linger in Armonk's fabric and at the Chamber's Cider and Donut Festival, celebrated each fall.

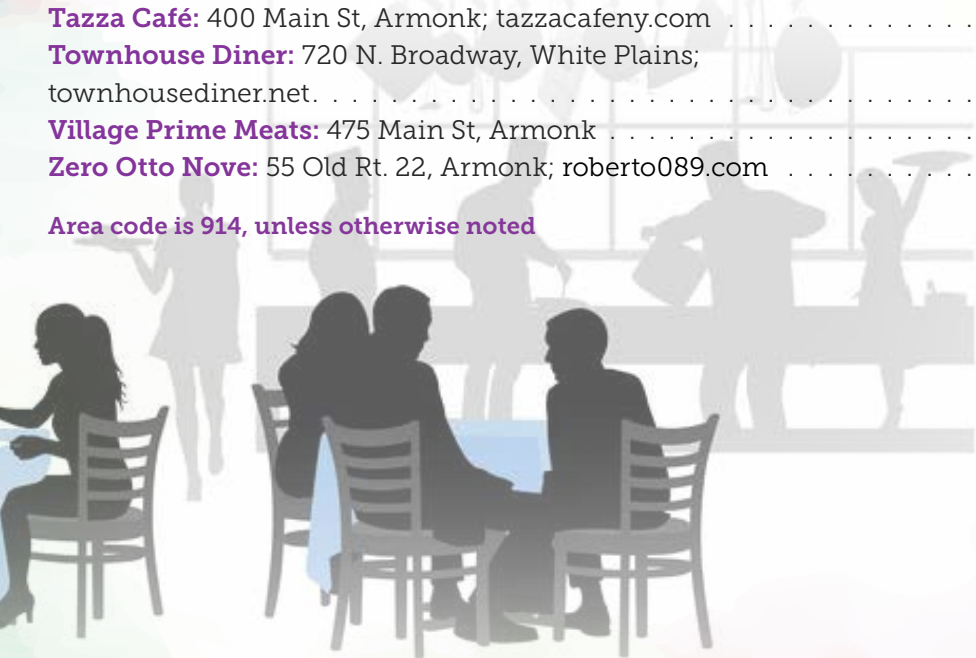

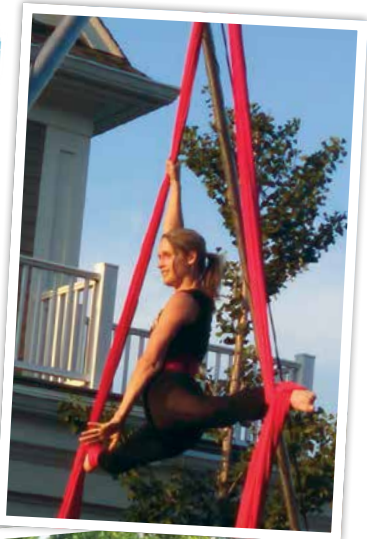

2018 Citizens

Armonk Independent Fire Department

The sense of family and duty to the community within the Armonk Independent Fire Department has continued for over 85 years, when three friends used three brooms to put out a brush fire in April 1930, thus recognizing the need to have people available for such an emergency. That need gave birth to the all-volunteer Armonk Independent Volunteer Fire Department three months later. It is in that tradition—providing selfless service and giving of one's self to help friends and neighbors—that makes the AIFD the first organization to be honored by the Armonk Chamber of Commerce as Citizens of the Year.

While none of those original volunteer firemen is still with us, two such stalwart veterans and ex-chiefs, John Heimerdinger and Mitch Sime, have more than 120 years of such community service between them. They cited that the organization's duties and responsibilities to the community were integral to creating the sense of family and camaraderie within the group.

In addition to fighting fires and providing emergency medical care to area residents and businesses, the AIFD also teaches fire safety to community, school and youth groups, and hosts two week-long community outreach programs yearly at the Armonk Firehouse. Since the Westchester County Airport is

among its responsibilities, the AIFD requires members to participate in multiagency drills in case of large scale emergencies, such as aircraft rescue and triage preparation for medical personnel.

The AIFD firefighters and emergency responders all undertake extensive training and refresher courses to keep their certifications current, as well as to provide the finest service to the residents of Armonk. The training classes entail 140 hours to become a firefighter, and 160 hours for EMTs.

The original firehouse on Maple Avenue, now the Hergenhan Center, "was the meeting place for our families," said Mitch Sime, the longest-serving member of the AIFD. "The firehouse was the main social center of the town. All the volunteers worked in or for the town. We all joined to help our friends and neighbors—and we've been doing it for a long time."

Added John Heimerdinger, also a long-time fire commissioner, "We welcome all residents to become involved as members. All serve with distinction. We have our first and only female fire chief, Luci Labriola-Cuffe, as well as a special associate member, Tommy Cox. He is a long-time resident and member of the AIFD, starting with the department when he was in elementary school."

With younger members, such as the newly elected fire chief Phil Goulet, and Carlos Cano, a 15-year department veteran and ex-chief, the AIFD has an active and bright future of service to Armonk and surrounding communities.

As far as the AIFD receiving this award, from the beginning, it was a clean sweep!

A vivacious and endearing presence in town and on Main Street for almost 30 years, Armonk's 2018 Citizen of the Year, Judy Gilmartin-Willsey, could star in her own movie right in her shop window. Judy, and her equally vibrant husband Carter, are the proprietors of Framings, a long-time downtown fixture.

Ever since coming to Armonk, Judy has been involved with its civic life; although residents of White Plains, Judy and Carter ostensibly call Armonk home. Actively supporting the construction of Armonk Square, Judy made a memorable plea before the town's Planning Board. Having co-founded the Armonk Chamber of Commerce (along with Debra La Gravinese and Ed Woodyard) in 2004, the Chamber now gets to honor its own "Ms. Main Street" for her years of dedicated service to the organization and the hamlet of Armonk.

As new parents of daughter Frannie, and recent escapees from Madison Avenue, they decided to open a frame shop similar to that of her parents. "Armonk was the only place that had the right feel for bringing up Frannie in a frame shop." Another key to their success was dedicating themselves

to high-end quality framing, a risk right after Black Monday in 1987, when the conventional wisdom was for a value-based bargain shop. "All of those stores have gone out of business. Quality reigns!" Framings has framed everything from family photos, to signed uniforms, to Calder and Picassos.

The first Framings store opened on Bedford Road in 1989, moving to a location which is now part of the DeCicco's parking lot, and finally to their strategic corner location on Main Street in 1996. Five years earlier, Judy involved herself with the formation of the Winter Walk, which evolved into Frosty Day in 2008, with the Framings family and staff hosting hot cider and holiday treats in their store every year during the festivities.

Judy became a driving force behind Frosty Day, as a founding board member of the Friends of Frosty Inc., overseeing the eager participation of businesses and merchants in the day's events. Through the years, she has collected historic Frosty items for her Frosty Museum, displayed in the store every winter.

During warmer weather, Judy can be seen pedaling around town on her bicycle. However, she refuses to acknowledge that she is channeling Almira Gulch in *The Wizard of Oz*, since she is too busy saying hi to people and singing a favorite tune or practicing for an upcoming performance with her a capella group, The Grace Notes. She also serves on the boards of several non-profit organizations.

An active proponent for the Armonk business community, Judy endorses the positive energy that independent retailers bring to the hamlet. As such, she is an enthusiastic town ambassador; her cheerful demeanor and positive outlook on life make her Armonk's own Pollyanna.

5th Annual Stayin' Alive 5K Fun Run

Stayin' Alive got its start in 2014, after the husbands of co-founders Michele Berliner and Christy Saltstein were critically injured during Hurricane Sandy. They survived due to the incredible determination and expertise of North Castle First Responders. In its first four years, the charity's 1,100 participants ran 20,000 miles, allowing for \$112,000 in grants.

Stayin' Alive's mission is to provide financial support to the First Responders of Northern Westchester. Donations go directly to local First Responders to assist in purchasing life-saving equipment not funded through their budgets. Last May, the 5K Fun Run had over 350 participants and raised close to \$40,000, which was distributed through the Stayin' Alive Grant Program. **Nine grants were awarded to local Fire Departments and Ambulance Corps, including: Armonk Independent Fire Company, Banksville Independent Fire Company, Bedford Hills Fire District, Chappaqua Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Lewisboro Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Independent Fire Co. of Mount Kisco, North White Plains Fire Department, Pleasantville Volunteer Fire Department, and Thornwood Fire Department.**

The North Castle Public Library: 79 Years Young



The North Castle Free Library in 1951

First conceived in 1936 by four local women on a mission to improve the quality of available reading materials, the North Castle Free Library opened its doors in 1938 in a small store at 21 Maple Avenue with 1,600 donated books. It operated there until 1941, when the founding women rallied to collect private donations from local residents. With substantial input from Armonk citizens, it moved to its current location at 19 Whippoorwill Road East. In 1961, its fundraising board, Friends of the North Castle Public Library, sponsored the first Armonk Outdoor Art Show. In 1963, having grown into such a valuable community resource, the library received its charter to operate as the North Castle Public Library. Now,

bigger and better than ever, its two branches are home to 105,000 books and other materials, 2,100 annual events and 163,000 visitors each year.

Exciting things are happening at our town's cultural and academic center:

- **Food at your fingertips!** A-Z Food, accessible from the library's homepage, provides the largest database of Global Food, Culture and Recipes.
- **New Teen Room-** Coming Spring 2018 to Armonk. Look for a bigger ADA-compliant, dedicated space with a youthful vibe, featuring a large screen TV for gaming, teen book collection, 3D printers and laptops.
- **New Community Space-** Stay tuned for Armonk's new, dedicated, private gathering space. This room will host smaller programs and offer a comfortable reading respite.
- **Children's Room Additions-** Check out the themed, early literacy kits for babies and toddlers. Life in the Fast Lane **Main Street, Armonk, April 1908**

In 1908, the First International Stock Car Race in America sped through Armonk. Today's Chinese American Christian Church is shown rear right. Car No. 20 is shown approaching on the dirt road. The farm on the left would become the famous Log Cabin Restaurant by the 1930s.

Race winner Lewis Strang said the roads were little better than cow paths and swamps. He claimed his fastest speed was 85 mph on the stretch near Mt. Kisco. We believe he was talking about Bishops Flats, just north of Armonk.

The route, approximately 32 miles long, was to be repeated eight times, for a total of 258 miles and went from Briarcliff through Millwood, Kitchawan, Pines Bridge, Mount Kisco, Wampus Lake, Armonk, Kensico, Valhalla, East View, Hawthorne and back to Briarcliff. This circuit was rated as the roughest and most perilous on which a road race had ever been held.

Americans use about 330 single-use plastic bags each per year -- over 3.5 million bags for North Castle residents. Plastic bags do not biodegrade or decompose but break up into micro plastic and are eaten by fish. Plastic bags can't be put in your curbside recycling bin because they clog up the recycling center machinery. Look for the green BYOB stickers at our local stores, and remember to BYOB!

Single Stream Recycling

Single stream recycling means paper, cardboard, plastic, glass and aluminum is mixed together in one container for pickup. Recyclables in plastic bags will **NOT** be picked up. All recycling should be loose in your container, except shredded paper, which *should* be placed in clear plastic bags. All your waste and recycling gets picked up once each week by the Town's hauler, **Suburban Carting (914-698-4300)**.



These items are not recyclable at curbside:

1. Plastic bags – Recycle at grocery stores and CVS.
2. Scrap metal – Drop off on the first Saturday of each month behind Town Hall.
3. Hazardous waste – Paint, automotive fluids, car batteries, pesticides, pool chemicals must be taken to the Westchester County Household Material Reclamation Facility in Valhalla.
4. Bio-hazardous waste – Syringes and needles, diapers and other sanitary products.
5. Non-recyclable plastics – Styrofoam, plastic utensils and straws.
6. Liquids - Empty and rinse out all containers.
7. Ceramics or non-recyclable glass – Ceramics, china, dishes, mirrors, light bulbs, Pyrex and window glass.



E-Waste Recycling: First Saturday of each month

E-waste (electronics) should be dropped off **behind Town Hall from 9 am to 1 pm**.

E-waste cannot be thrown out; it must be recycled. E-waste contains components with high levels of toxicity and contaminants, which can pollute the soil, water and air. All scrap metal should be left at the curb for regular pickup.

Accepted e-waste:

Computers and monitors, towers, keyboards, mice, ink cartridges, printers, scanners, fax machines, cables, wiring, AV equipment, televisions, video game consoles, VCRs, DVRs, digital converter boxes, telephones, network equipment, PDAs, iPods, radios, speakers, calculators, electronic motors, metal stoves, refrigerators, microwaves, metal toasters, toaster ovens, metal lawn mowers (gas removed).

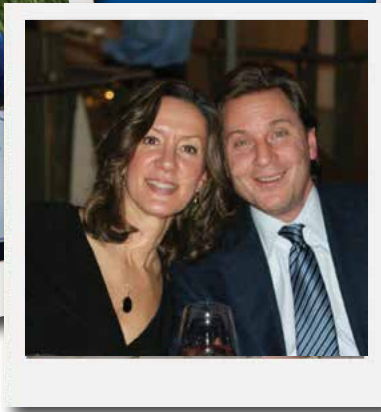
