Setting the Standard

This new approach, which replaces desktop and full reviews every four years with categorical reviews, has streamlined our workflows and standardized costs. This change has not only benefited the agencies we serve but also enhanced our organizational efficiency. Additionally, we are proud to have earned Accreditation from the Better Business Bureau's Wise Giving Alliance, a testament to our dedication to excellence and transparency.

Bold Leadership

Professional development remained a cornerstone of our efforts. We introduced new continuing education programs for HR and fundraising professionals, tailored to the needs and feedback of our nonprofit community. We continued to offer in person, hybrid, and virtual trainings to meet the needs of our constituents. The expansion of our Rising Leaders and Advancing Leaders programs allowed us to connect with even more local nonprofits, fostering leadership and collaboration.

The Community Circle

Community engagement was at the heart of our activities this year. Our staff volunteered at various local organizations, strengthening our ties within the community.
