





DUNCOLN COUNTY HEALTH DEPART BEAT THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT **Hot Weather Safety Tips**

- Stay hydrated. Drink a lot of water.
- Avoid alcoholic beverages, coffee, tea and sodas
- Avoid going outside in extreme heat. Limit outside activity to early morning or late evening.
- If you don't have air conditioning, keep shades drawn and blinds closed, but windows slightly open.
 - Keep lights off or turned down.
 - Limit the use of your stove
- · Wear lightweight, loose, light-colored clothing.
- · Wear sunscreen. Sunburn affects your body's ability to cool down and can make you dehydrated.
- · Take cool baths and showers
- · Don't leave anyone, including pets, in a parked car- even for a




