Mark and Tina Scott started WE DO STUMP GRINDING in April 2022 and are now in their third season of grinding, serving Merrill and the surrounding areas, and they've ground stumps for customers in Wausau, Athens, Edgar, Gleason, Mosinee, Tomahawk, and many points in between.

"The number one reason people have stumps ground out is because they are really a pain to mow around," Tina said. "Probably the second reason is because they don't like how they make their yard look, and the third is because they lost trees due to rot or storm damage."

"We really focus on fast service and good service," Mark said. "We return calls promptly and show up as promised, and we make sure our customers are happy with the work we do."

"You don't need to have your yard ripped up by a bulldozer to get rid of the stumps in your yard," Tina said. "With our narrow machine on tracks, we don't damage your lawn and you'll barely know we were there."

"And that narrow machine also lets us get in through narrow walkways and gates in enclosed yards without having to take down any fences," Mark said.




