2023 Golden Apple Excellence in Education Nomination



The Portage County Business Council's Partners in Education Committee seeks to recognize teachers who have made significant contributions to education and work with future leaders. *The Golden Apple Award* is given annually to a teacher who exemplifies creativity, enthusiasm, commitment and development of a positive learning environment. The selected recipient and all nominees will be recognized at PCBC's Creative Excellence Awards Breakfast on Friday, April 14th, 2023. ***Nominations are due by Wednesday, March 1, 2023***.

Who is eligible? Nominees must be a Pre-K to 12th grade teacher from a public or private school serving students from Portage County with at least one year of teaching in their current district. Nominees for this award should exhibit innovative teaching strategies, demonstrate enthusiasm and vitality in teaching, and inspire students to learn. Nominees should go above and beyond in their role, supporting students and fellow educators.

Who can submit a nomination? Anyone can nominate a teacher for the award; a student, a parent, fellow teacher or community member. An individual may nominate only one person for the award. Nominations may include optional letters of support from other parents, colleagues, students, former students, etc. These letters should describe the attributes that the nominee possesses that make him/her an outstanding teacher.
