Welcome to 2023!

I hope everyone had a safe and happy holiday season and you are ready for the new year!

This is an exciting time for all of Portage County! We have so many new things in the works.

The Food + Farm Exploration Center is well on it's way, just south of Lake Pacawa and Pacawa Park in the Village of Plover. There are 51 new homes being built in Plover as well. That's not all. Stay tuned for an announcement of a new restaurant looking to locate in Plover!

Our neighbors to the east are booming as well, the Village of Amherst has a new addition in their Business Park. Legacy Platform's new building is being built in the Business Park on the east side of town. They are an industrial steel supplier and are very excited to be starting operations here in 2023.

Stevens Point is also changing and growing. Starting with redevelopment of the old Wal-Mart property on Highway 10 and Brilowski, which will become a Big Lots, Five Below and other mid-box retailers. Downtown the Northside Yard is adding it's third building to the complex with town houses coming on the Portage Street side of the property. Then a new hotel will be going up less than a block from the Portage County Business Council – the Home2 Suites by Hilton will be in the neighborhood.

Thank you to the voters of Stevens Point for approving Badger Avenue expansion and the new railroad siding. Badger Avenue expansion will be going from E.M. Copps drive near Lineage Logistics due south to County HH (McDill Avenue). This extension will take 100's of trucks off Brilowski sending them south to HH and then west to the I-39 interchange. The rail siding will allow for the expansion of Lineage Logistics which is adding on again and this buildout will be adding twelve rail dock doors, but keep an eye on the East Park Commerce Center much more news to come!

I want to let you know all of these things happening because there is so much great excitement going on and people need to know that Portage County is on a growth curve. People are realizing that this is a great place to Live, Work and Thrive!!!



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
