Although we weren't able to enjoy WinterFest in the way we are accustomed to, it was wonderful to see that all of the events had a fantastic turnout. Throughout the weekend, people were definitely ready to enjoy the unseasonably warm temperatures and get out of the house. Getting out and gathering as a community is what WinterFest is all about.

#### Some highlights included:

- The Candlelight Walk at the Wisconsin Concrete Park drew over 200 guests to enjoy the beautiful trail, bonfire and treats.
- 250 anglers took part in the ice fishing tournament, and over \$3,300 in cash and prizes were awarded.
- The Phillips Flurry hosted 103 in-person snowshoers, with another 40 participating virtually.
- There were plenty of activities for kids and families throughout the weekend, with great turn out at the Kids' Bingo sponsored by the Phillips Moose Lodge, and "Snow" much fun event along with a Chili Dinner at Our Savior Lutheran Church.
- Saturday was capped off with a rockin' celebration at Elk Lake Park, with WinterFest fireworks sponsored by local snowmobile clubs, a bonfire by the Lugerville Chasers and an ice skating party hosted by the Girl Scouts featuring treats and music.
- The Phillips Chaparrals hosted a successful breakfast at Harbor View on Sunday morning, where the Price County Tavern League drew for the winners of the Tavern League Tour.
- Two local businesses took part in our snow sculpture contest, which was a feat due to the lack of snow this year.
- 888 slips were returned from shoppers at local businesses as part of our WinterFest Shop Local promotion.








# **Edit Member Contact Info:**

- 2. Click Save


# **Create a Job Listing:**
