Bike Aid Stations: IRONMAN athletes go through a great deal of fluids and food in their quest to become an IRONMAN. Aid Stations are an integral part of the race, and the spirit of an Aid Station reflects on the whole event. Have Fun with it! Come up with a theme... dress up, decorate, cheer on the athletes.

Volunteers will hand out water, Gatorade, and food to athletes as they pass through the aid station. Clean up and pack up your area when you're done. Some items from aid station will be available for donation.

Run Aid Stations: Volunteers will hand out water, Gatorade, and food to athletes as they pass through the aid station.

Transition: Assist with various tasks in the Transition area

Environmental: The environmental team is an integral part in the success of any IRONMAN race. Our goal at IRONMAN events is to leave the community cleaner than when we arrived. As with any event of this size, IRONMAN Events generate an enormous amount of garbage. It is our job to manage the extraordinary amount of trash and dispose of it in a proper manner. This team of volunteers will help ensure that the venue is free from garbage. There will also be a team that will go out on the bike and run course to ensure the course is 100% clean.

Kayak/ Canoe/SUP: IRONMAN / WTC does NOT supply Kayaks for this area. Volunteers should bring their own canoe/kayak/SUP. You must be confident in your ability to keep your Kayak upright, if an athlete needs to hold onto to your watercraft. Volunteers assigned to the CKS are stationed around the course for safety purposes and serve as directional guides for athletes. There will be a brief skills assessment and water safety meeting for this area.

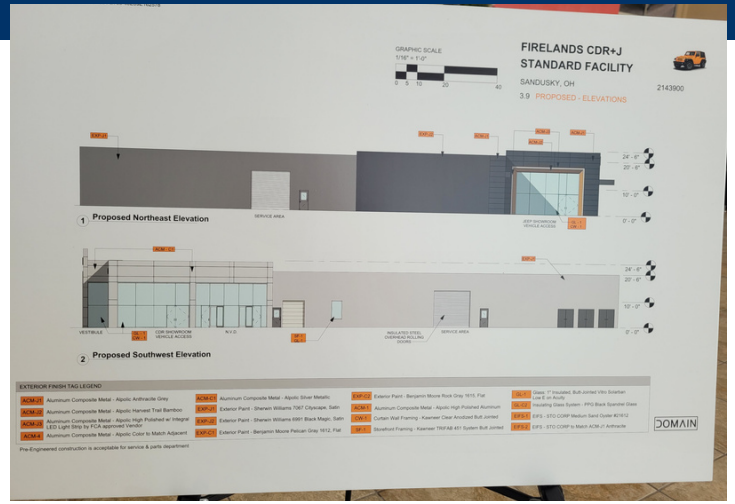
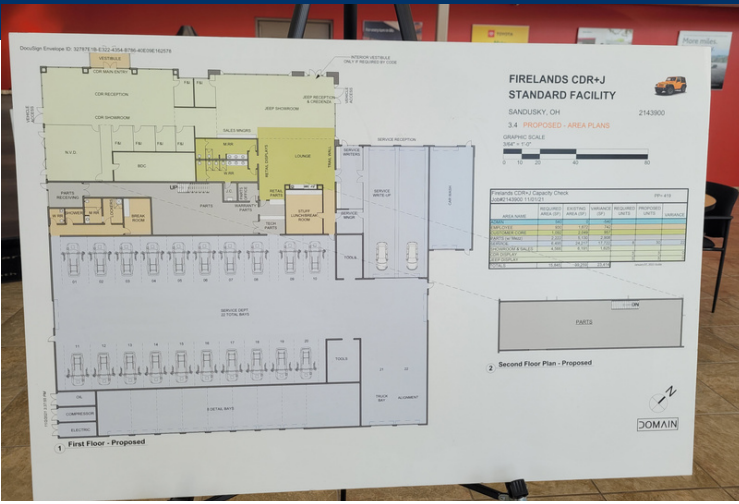

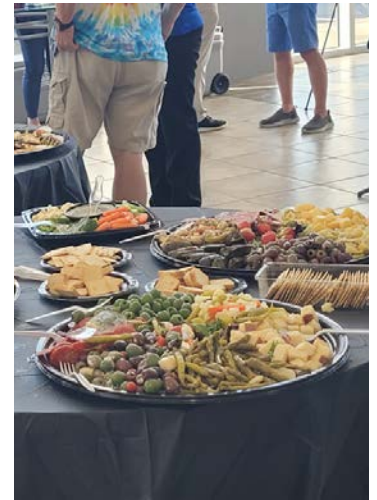

PROTECT YOURSELF

As we have learned from public PUCO investigations, some sale agents may use dishonest sales tactics to sign customers up for unfavorable supply contracts. Even worse, the Federal Trade Commission and Ohio Attorney General have warned of scammers using cold-calling techniques to lure customers into sending them money or information.

Here's what to look out for:

- Rebate offers for staying in agreements with high variable rates
- Introductory or variable prices that can change monthly and are often above market prices
- Callers claiming you can terminate your current agreement without early termination fees
- Phone calls or emails that demand immediate payment
- Threats that your power will be shut off unless you comply



Here are some tips to protect yourself:

- Never give out personal information (bank account info, SSN, energy account number) to anyone whose identity you are unable to confirm
- If you receive a call from someone claiming to be a representative from your utility, collect their information, hang up, and call your provider using their confirmed number found on your bill or the utility's website
- Read through all contracts thoroughly before agreeing to them

If you are concerned with a recent call you've received or think that you may be wrapped up in an unfavorable contract, we are here to help. Simply call 330-409-7892 or fill out the bill review request and send your most recent electric and natural gas bills to billreview@ceateam.com.
