2024 PAYNE NICKLES & COMPANY ACCOUNTING SCHOLARSHIP RENAMED IN HONOR OF TODD SPORE

- Minimum 2.8 grade point average.
- Completion of the Universal Scholarship Application online at https://www.huronccf.org/scholarships by March 1st, 2024.

Selection for this prestigious scholarship will be based on merit, financial need, and community involvement, reflecting Todd Spore's dedication to service. The scholarship will be disbursed directly to the institution in one installment, ensuring it aids in covering educational expenses.

Interested applicants are encouraged to visit the Huron County Community Foundation website at www.huronccf.org for detailed application instructions. Payne Nickles is pleased to partner with the Erie County & Huron County Community Foundations, which allow applicants to apply for numerous scholarship opportunities at once through an easy, accessible online application. A final decision will be announced in July.




