- Fire Chief approves qualifications with Strike Team Leader and above submitted for second approval from Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Committee

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How to qualify

ALL HAZARDS (non-wildland) Deployment

- Training
 - NFPA 1001 Standards for Firefighter
 - SFFMA accredited NFPA Firefighter I/II or accredited Advanced Firefighter
 - > TCFP Basic Firefighter
- This is the minimal level to participate on an All Hazards deployment (not required for Wildland deployment)

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HOW TO QUALIFY

WILDLAND Deployment

- Training
 - \$130/\$190, L180, I100
 - TFS contracted Fire in the Field (FIF) 100 (I100, S130, S190, and L180) with Skills Day
 - SFFMA Curriculum with Wildland Certification (after June 2008)
 - RT-130 (Wildland Refresher) within last 12 months
 - Arduous Work Capacity (Pack) Test [effective 01/01/2021]
- **Recognized Certifications:**
 - NWCG S130/S190/L180 Course Certification
 - TIFMAS S130/S190/L180 Course Certification
 - SFFMA Wildland Certification completed on or after June 2008 with TFS/NWCG or TIFMAS Basic Wildland Course Certificate
 - TCFP Basic Wildland Certification
- Minimal level to participate on a Wildland deployment (Not required for All Hazards deployment)

- And complete the following

 - PMS-419 Wildland Engine Operator (an evaluated equivalency may be substituted at TFS discretion)

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Task Books

- Advanced Wildland Firefighter (FFI/ICT5)
- Initiated by Fire Chief or Designee
- Minimum of two (2) assignments as a trainee
- · At least two (2) different evaluators
- Minimum of one (1) ICS 225 prior to completion of task book
- After final evaluation (by qualified final evaluator):
 - Fire Chief approves qualification
 - Submits all documents to <u>TIFMAS@tfs.tamu.edu</u> for final review
 - Position Task Book
 - Cover Letter / Checklist from Fire Chief or designee
 - ICS 225 with positive review
 - Other supporting documentation as required
- Task books should be completed within five (5) years of the date of the first evaluation record

Task Books

- Engine Boss (ENGB)Initiated by Fire Chief or designee
- At least three (3) assignments as a trainee
 - At least one (1) out of home unit
 - At least one (1) multi-operational wildfire
- At least two (2) different fuel types
- At least two (2) different evaluators At least one (1) ICS 225 prior to completion of the task book
- After final evaluation (by qualified final evaluator):
 - Fire Chief approves qualification
 - Submits all documents to <u>TIFMAS@tfs.tamu.edu</u> for final review
 - Position Task Book
 - Cover Letter / Checklist from Fire Chief or designee
 - ICS 225 with positive review
 - Other supporting documentation as required
- Task books should be completed within five (5) years of the date of the first evaluation record

Task Books

- Strike Team Leader (STEN)

 - At least three (3) assignments as a trainee
 - At least one (1) out of home unit

 - · At least two (2) different evaluators
 - At least one (1) ICS 225 prior to completion of the task book

Task Books

- After final evaluation (by qualified final evaluator):
 Fire Chief <u>recommends</u> qualification (do not sign <u>Agency Certification</u>)
 - Submits all documents to <u>TIFMAS@tfs.tamu.edu</u> for final review · Position Task Book

 - Cover Letter / Checklist from Fire Chief or designee
 - ICS 225 with positive review
 - Copies of certificates for required courses
 - Other supporting documentation as required • A Resume is recommended for these qualifications
 - TIFMAS Qualification Coordinator verifies package is complete and submits to Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Committee (meet
 - RPL Committee reviews and issues approval or prescription with guidelines to applicant
 - If RPL prescribes additional work, applicant remains in trainee status until resubmission with updated checklist and documentation for review and approval

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Task Books

Task Book Exceptions

- Task 39 in ENGB Task Book can be accomplished on a Wildfire (W) or at an Incident (I) or exercise involving actual aerial operations with EMS air resources
- Multiple day assignment requirement with IMT interaction for ENGB and STEN can be met on a Wildfire (W) or All Hazard assignment

How to recertify

- Done as an entire department at a time
 - Five year cycle (effective 2016)
- **Qualification Recertification Forms**
 - Sent via email to each department's designated representative
- Department's Representative verifies the following:
 - Member is still with the department
 - Member has completed the renewal requirements for their qualification level
- Forms reviewed, signed, and sent to TIFMAS@tfs.tamu.edu
- TIFMAS cards are no longer being printed

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HOW TO RECERTIFY

- All Hazards / Structural Follow TCFP/SFFMA \underline{annual} recertification standards
- Basic Wildland Firefighter (FFII)

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- Complete <u>annual</u> fireline safety refresher (RT-130) with training fire shelter
- Complete <u>annual</u> Arduous Work Capacity (Pack) Test [effective 01/01/2021]
- Engine Operator (ENOP), Firefighter I (FFI), Engine Boss (ENGB), ICT4, Strike Team Leader (STEN), Task Force Leader (TFLD), Division / Group Supervisor
- Complete Basic Wildland Firefighter (FFII) Recertification Requirements, AND Complete at least one Performance Evaluation (ICS-225) within five (5) year timeframe (One ICS-225 at the highest TIFMAS qualification level counts for all
- Faller 3 (FAL3) Must complete an approved saw refresher course every two (2)

HOW TO DEPLOY

Information Needed Prior to Deployment

- Vehicle "Name" and License Plate Number
- Names of Personnel (ensure all are currently qualified for the assignment)
- **Personnel Cell Phone Numbers**
- Person in Charge of the Crew
- 24-Hour Contact Phone Number at Home Agency (Departmental Emergency Contact Number)

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REIMBURSEMENTS

All Deployments are now reimbursed "Portal-to-Portal"


- Reimbursed for all hours from time deployment begins to time returned to home unit
- Vehicles are reimbursed based on actual hours worked (NO fuel)

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REIMBURSEMENTS

- Resources returning to their home base with regularly scheduled shift the day of return or the day following their return
- Additional backfill not to exceed 24 hours will be granted
- Insures proper rest for firefighters

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REIMBURSEMENTS


- Includes up to two hours prior to deployment for preparation
- Includes up to two hours after return for returning equipment to service
- Includes "Backfill" for normal shift when a minimum staffing policy is in place

REIMBURSEMENTS

- Per Diem follows local agency guidelines
- The TIFMAS Business Manual provides a guideline if the local agency does not have one
