

It is time to renew your dues for 2024 – 2025 ✓

We'd like to welcome new members **Barbara Cushing, Julie Bush, and Ann Carroll** to our group. It was great to see **Jane Lee** back as well. We welcomed guests **Jean Lynch** and **Sandy Van Dorp**, who we hope might join us, as well.

The SPCREA calendar year runs from July 1st to June 30th. FREA begins membership renewal in February for the upcoming year. If you are not sure if you are current (2024-2025), please check with *Paula Walker* or *Carol Huber*. Several have paid in advance and they are being updated to our current year.

SPCREA will send you a reminder to renew your dues via email to members receiving newsletters in that format. You may also receive a reminder from **FREA** regarding state dues (local dues are not included). *To save time and confusion, I suggest that you pay both state and local dues though SPCREA*.

Give/send your dues to Paula and updated personal information to Carol. Paula will designate that both state & local dues are paid, send that information to me, and remit state dues to FREA. Your status will then be updated to current. *Combined state and local dues are only \$45*.

You might consider setting up auto pay directly from your bank to Paula. It's not difficult, and I have done it for several years. Using your bank's bill payer section, set up an annual payment to Paula Walker on a specific date (I use January 15th). Your bank will then generate a check that will be sent to Paula for the amount you designate. However, you will still need to contact Paula or me with any updates (email, address, etc.) This is an easy way to pay your dues and stay current without wondering about your status.

SPCREA currently boasts **54 current members** who are up-to-date for the **2024-25** year, and *67 members* who need <u>renewal</u> from 2023 – 2024. Please check with Paula or myself for your current status. Please encourage your friends, acquaintances, and colleagues to bring their membership up-to-date and join us at our meetings and outings. You never know when the opportunity will present itself. Paula & I were working at Panera last week, when a retired teacher overheard us and asked about our program. We hope to see her at our next meeting! Be sure to keep our new brochures handy for just such occasions!!


