

Second, Macomb Business Academy (MBA) will start again this Fall. MBA is a program designed to develop leadership potential within the community to meet the demands of tomorrow. MBA identifies emerging leaders within the Macomb area and provides a broad view of civic leadership through direct contact with the leaders and institutions shaping the community. The program, which is sponsored by MidAmerica National Bank, runs from September through November with weekly, two-hour sessions. 

**Macomb Park District - Patton Park**: The Ambassador Committee of the Macomb Area Chamber of Commerce held a ribbon cutting for the Macomb Park District on July 8 to celebrate the recent addition of new Pathways for Play® pocket playground areas at Patton Park, located off Grant Street in Macomb. Pathways for Play intentionally integrates play into neighborhood areas to provide opportunities for playing along the way and encourages use by children and families. The purpose of Pathways for Play is to promote play – critical for children's health – into walkable, bikeable, "play pockets" providing the option to fully explore recreational areas. The enhancements are part of the park district's Push 4 Parks - Patton Park Project campaign, a proposed development that includes multiple new recreational and play features, beautification efforts, natural restoration initiatives, and opportunities for community involvement.



<u>Macomb Park District - Everwood disc golf</u> The Ambassador Committee of the Macomb Area Chamber of Commerce held a ribbon cutting on June 14 for the Macomb Park District, as they upgraded the baskets on the 18-hole Everwood disc course golf that shares locations in neighboring Glenwood and Everly Parks in Macomb. 
