The BOCC recently allocated \$300,000 to the Citrus County Chamber of Commerce for a grant program for businesses that furloughed employees due to COVID-19 and have since rehired them. To qualify, the business must have furloughed an employee for a minimum of two months before rehiring and steadily employing for a minimum of 90 days. The grant amount is \$2,000 per rehired fulltime equivalent employee.

All local businesses are eligible. Complete information on the grant program and documentation required is on the application form.

It is preferred that businesses use the online application. However, in the event that is not possible, the application form may be printed and mailed back along with the required documentation. Application are open at www.Citrus FurloughRehire@gmail.com

Small Business Grants Funding Extended

The Citrus County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) has extended its Citrus County Small Business Grant Programs. There are two programs available to small businesses with less than 35 employees:

● The Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Micro Grant will have a minimum award of \$250 up to a maximum award of \$2,500.
