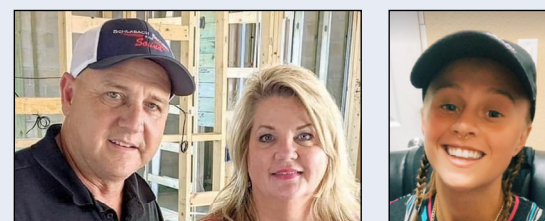


'Chamber Report' on WYKE
