THE TECH CHECKPOINT | DECEMBER 2020

DATA INSIGHT

As we happily conclude 2020, the KC Tech Checkpoint report remains in a downward trend for both the Kansas City area and the United States. As expected, the job market took a hit during the holiday season and the total job postings for the Kansas City metro area decreased by 17.7% with 3,148 total postings. The United States job postings for December also experienced a decrease by 11.3% for a total of 390,232 postings.

For December, the Top 10 Occupations experienced a decrease across the board for their total number of postings except for one occupation, Database Administrator (+6). Software Developer had the largest decline with -154 postings, for a total of 836. Computer User Support Specialist followed as a close second with -144 postings for December (792 total).

December's Top 10 Certifications continues to lead with CISSP, which has 77 total postings (-26). There are two returning certifications to make the Top 10 for December, MCSE (20) and CSM (18). The only two certifications to experience an increase this month include CCNP, +1, and CISA +5. The A+ Certification experienced the smallest decrease for December with -1, for a total of 19 postings.

The Top 10 Hard Skills for December continues to follow the downward trend we see for this month. Computer Programming/Coding maintains the lead for the seventh month in a row, with 618 postings (-78). Agile experienced the largest drop for December with 509 postings (-112). Oracle had the least amount of change from November with 424 postings (-14).

The Top 10 Hirers of Tech Talent welcomes a new employer to the Top 10, Revature (28 postings). Oracle continues to lead the Top 10 Hirers for December with 270 total postings (+8). Cerner experienced the largest decrease this month with 84 total postings (-18). There are two returning Top 10 Employers for December, KForce (59 postings) and H&R Block (34 postings).

EMERGING IT TRENDS

The information technology industry's strategic focus has shifted from slow adoption of new, state-of-the-art technologies to enhanced IT infrastructure and operational necessities over the last few months. The 2020 pandemic has completely shifted consumer and business needs, and the IT industry will be headed in a new direction as we dive into 2021.
