





The Adopt-a-Home Program is a revitalization program aimed at providing new life to abandoned or neglected homes. The program connects home buyers with properties available for rehabilitation and provides an easy reference list of standard housing codes that new owners would need to be aware of in order to bring the home back into a habitable state.

In some cases the city has already contacted the owners and even possibly secured transferrable title making it easy for interested buyers to purchase the homes at a discounted rate and quickly begin restoration plans.





International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme of Rockingham County

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme of Rockingham County at **Reidsville High School** began offering classes in fall of 1997. At that time, it was chosen as one of only four high schools in North Carolina authorized by the IB Organization to offer the program.

The IB programme offers a quality curriculum that encourages critical thinking through the study of traditional disciplines while encouraging a global perspective. It challenges students to not only excel in their studies, but also grow in personal development. The program encourages independent learning, supporting the student in creating their own learning path and objectives. Many times the program leads students to participate in educational programs at some of the highest ranking universities around the world.


