Credit Rating Downgrade

The credit rating agency Fitch Ratings downgraded the U.S. government's top credit rating to AA+. The highest rating possible is AAA which the U.S. has held for decades. Fitch Ratings shared that their rationale for the downgrade was partly due to doubts about the government's ability to tackle increasing debt, as they see evidence in repeated debt-limit standoffs. U.S. Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen criticized the decision.

Credit ratings are akin to one's credit score, so one may question if the U.S. downgrade will impact their finances as a resident. Many experts and analysts note that the **financial impact** is more likely to be long-term rather than immediate. For example, interest rates will remain elevated on credit cards, mortgages and auto loans for longer. The stock market dropped after the announcement, but some experts think that may be temporary.
