## November 14 Luncheon Legislative Panel



### Senator Jabo Waggoner

Senator Waggoner, born in Birmingham, Alabama, on January 8, 1937, is serving his 8th term in the Senate after serving from 1966-1983 in the House of Representatives. Senator Waggoner received his BA degree from Birmingham Southern College and his JD degree from Birmingham School of Law. He and his wife, Marilyn, are the parents of four children and grandparents of seven and one great grandchild.



### Senator Dan Roberts

State Senator Dan Roberts represents Senate District 15, which includes Jefferson & Shelby counties. He has served as a State Senator since 2018. He currently serves as Chair of the Contract Review Committee and sits on the Senate committees for Rules, State Governmental Affairs, Healthcare, Banking & Insurance, Children & Youth Health, Finance & Taxation Education and Fiscal Responsibility & Economic Development.



### Representative Mike Shaw

Mike Shaw was elected to the State Legislature representing District 47 (Vestavia Hills and Hoover) in November of 2022 with 64% of the vote. Prior to that, he served on the Hoover City Council for 6 years.

Mike holds a degree in Public Administration from Auburn University, but started a career in technology soon after graduating in 1995. The majority of his subsequent technology career has been in financial



### Representative David Faulkner

David Faulkner is Alabama State Representative for District 46. A father of three, with the support of his wife Nancy, David was elected in 2014 and represents the people of Alabama's District 46 in the State Legislature. District 46 is comprised of portions of Mountain Brook, Homewood, and Hoover.

David's foremost priorities in his representative duties are improvements in the state's educational system and economic development for the state of Alabama. David regularly meets with his District's PTOs at all



### Commissioner Mike Bolin

Commissioner Mike Bolin was elected to serve as the Jefferson County Commissioner to represent District 5 in July of 2023. He is a lifelong resident of Jefferson County, Alabama, and attended elementary school in Birmingham and middle school in Homewood.

Senator Waggoner is a Republican and a member of the Homewood Church of Christ. He serves on the following boards: Executive Committee of Birmingham Business Alliance; Faulkner University Board of Trustees; Greater Birmingham Convention and Visitors Bureau; Alabama Sports Hall of Fame. He is a member of Hoover, Homewood, Shelby County, Vestavia Hills Chambers of Commerce; 50-Year member Civitan International; member of Masons and Shriners organizations; member of the Monday Morning Quarterback Club. He was inducted into the Birmingham Southern College Sports Hall of Fame, 2007, and received the Birmingham Southern Distinguish Alumni in 2013.

His years of community leadership and service include the Entrepreneurs Round Table, Alabama Policy Institute, Racerunners, Young Business Leaders, Campus Outreach International, College Golf Fellowship, and Leachman Ministries and serving as an Elder at Briarwood Presbyterian Church.

## SELECTING AND ELECTION OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

### Article IV - Section 2

A. Nominating Committee: At the regular September meeting of the Board, the President shall appoint, subject to approval by the Board, a Nominating Committee consisting of three (3) members of the Chamber. The Executive Director shall serve in an advisory capacity to the Nominating Committee. The President shall designate the Chair of the Nominating Committee.

The Nominating Committee shall present to the Board for approval prior to October 31, a slate of candidates to serve as Directors and Officers of the Chamber for the following year. Each candidate must be a Member in good standing and must have agreed to accept the expected responsibilities. No Member who has served two consecutive years as a Director is eligible to be a Director for a third consecutive year. A period of one (1) year must elapse before eligibility is restored. The Chair of the Nominating Committee shall strive to notify those Directors who are not eligible for reappointment pursuant to this term limit.

B. Publication of Nominations: Within ten (10) days of receipt of the report of the Nominating Committee, the President shall give Notice to the general membership of the names of persons nominated as candidates for Directors and Officers and the right of petition as contemplated in these Bylaws.

C. Nomination by Petition: Additional names of candidates for Directors and Officers may be nominated by a petition bearing the genuine signatures of at least fifteen (15) Members of the Chamber. Such petition shall be submitted to the presiding President within ten (10) days after Notice has been given of the original nomination as contemplated in Article IV(2)(B). The determination of the Board as to whether the petition(s) complies with these Bylaws for consideration shall be final.

D. Determination: If no valid petition is properly submitted within the designated period, the nominations shall be closed and the nominated slate of candidates shall be declared elected by the Board of the Chamber at the Annual Meeting, regardless of whether a Quorum is present at such meeting.

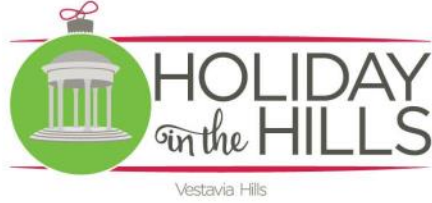
