#### HURRICANE IAN RELIEF COLLECTION DRIVE



Our thoughts and prayers are with those across Central Florida and the state who have been impacted by Hurricane Ian. The devastation and destruction that occurred throughout our state is unprecedented.

In response, the Central Florida Hotel & Lodging Association was focused this week on helping our community and state in its recovery efforts.

On Wednesday, October 5th, we hosted our CFHLA Cares Collection Drive which was expanded to include items for Hurricane Ian relief.

Thanks to the generous support from our Members and the community, we collected more than 50,345 items, which included toiletry and hygiene items, school supplies, non-perishable food items and men's and women's clothing.

The donated items were then donated to the <u>Orange County Public</u> <u>Schools, School District of Osceola County, Seminole County</u> <u>Public School, Senior Resource Alliance</u> and <u>Hope Now</u> <u>International</u>.





#### HEART OF FLORIDA UNITED WAY OPENS APPLICATIONS FOR EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

In response to the effects of Hurricane Ian on Central Florida residents, the Heart of Florida United Way (HFUW) has opened the application for one-time assistance for food & emergency supplies.

The online application can be completed at

www.HFUW.org/Hurricanelan. Applicants must be over the age of 18, residents of Orange, Seminole or Osceola counties, and must attest they were adversely impacted by Hurricane Ian. Impacts can include loss of income due to work closures, loss of food, or damage to property. Only one application per household can be submitted for the assistance which will come in the form of a Wal-Mart e-gift card in the amount of \$300.

The assistance being provided through the Hurricane Recovery Fund is aimed at supporting ALICE – Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed – families in Central Florida. Support will be offered for as long as dollars are available from contributions of community partners and individuals. The application for assistance may be intermittently closed for processing. It is encouraged for individuals to check back if they receive this message as applications are processed daily.
