VOTE YES ON TRANSPORTATION

On November 8th, we have the opportunity to vote on a transformational change to Orange County's transportation system.

A <u>YES Vote for Transportation</u> means that we will finally have a dedicated funding source for our long-term transportation and infrastructure needs in Orange County. This dedicated funding source will generate \$600 million annually and more than half of it will be paid by our tourists/non-residents.

As outlined in the <u>Orange County Transportation Initiative Plan</u>, this funding will be spent on expanding mass transit, improving our roads, adding new safety measures and significantly enhancing our transportation and technology infrastructure.

A <u>YES Vote for Transportation</u> could potentially **triple** Orange County's transit system, creating more frequent, reliable, and faster LYNX bus service. It will **expand** SunRail service to seven days a week, **connect** SunRail to the airport and the convention center as well as establish new East-West connections. Furthermore, much needed improvements will be made for the safety of our pedestrians and roadways.

On behalf of CFHLA and our PAC/PC, we urge you to share the importance of a <u>YES vote for Transportation</u> with your team members, family members, neighbors, and others. We need to get out the vote. It is vital that the residents of Orange County be informed of the difference that a local funding source dedicated to transportation can achieve for our region.

BRANDI NUTT OF LIKI TIKI VILLAGE RESORT AWARDED SERVICE AWARD



This week, the Central Florida Hotel & Lodging Association was proud to award **Brandi Nutt**, **security coordinator at the Liki Tiki Village Resort**, as the fourth CFHLA Security & Safety Council Service Award of 2022.

Earlier this year, Brandi encountered a water submersion incident that involved a three-year-old at her property. After arriving on the scene, Brandi not only controlled the area around the incident but also provided comfort to the family, who was distraught. After explaining that the child was alert and communicating, she helped calm the family as they waited for Orange County Fire & Rescue to arrive.

Once Orange County Fire & Rescue arrived, they evaluated the child and advised the family that his oxygen levels were stable. However, the child needed to be transported to the local hospital for a more in-depth evaluation. We are happy to report the child is doing just fine today.

Then while the investigation into the water submersion was occurring, another emergency medical call came from a guest unit. Without hesitation, Security Coordinator Nutt and a deputy responded to the unit and found an unresponsive male guest. They immediately performed CPR until the Fire & Rescue was able to arrive again and transport the guest to the Hospital.
