CFHLA FOUNDATION AWARDS GRANTS TO FOUR LOCAL ENTITIES

Did you know? The <u>CFHLA Foundation</u> was created in 2009 to serve as a community partner and the philanthropy arm of CFHLA.

Since its inception, the CFHLA Foundation and its board of directors has distributed more than **\$1 Million in student scholarships** and provided community grants to organizations that help advance community initiatives through hospitality.

At the CFHLA Membership Luncheon on Thursday, November 3rd, the CFHLA Foundation was proud to award **four more grants totaling \$60,000**, to incredibly deserving organizations that help to advance our community in education and workforce development, supporting the expansion of the arts and culture of our community, and offering attainable housing and community building for all.

These four CFHLA Foundation grants include:



\$25,000 to the **Dr. Phillips Center for the Performing Arts**. This grant fulfills year 8 of 10 in our long-term commitment, **totaling \$250,000** in support of their work.



\$20,000 to <u>Lift Orlando</u>, which fulfills year 5 of 5 in our long-term commitment of **\$100,000** to this amazing organization which has done incredible work in reshaping the outlook for the 32804 and 32805 zip codes.



A new two-year commitment to the <u>UCF Rosen College of Hospitality</u> <u>Management</u>, for \$10,000 annually and \$20,000 total.

And a brand-new partnership with <u>Seminole State College's</u> <u>Hospitality and Tourism Management Program</u>, with a **\$5,000** grant to support this new program.

LEE CONSTANTINE AWARDED 2021 PUBLIC SERVANT OF THE YEAR HONOR



On Thursday, November 3rd, CFHLA was also proud to award our 2021 Public Servant of the Year Award to Seminole County Commissioner Lee Constantine.

For more than 40 years, Commissioner Constantine has remained a steadfast and dedicated "tourism champion" for the Central Florida region. This includes his 18 years of support in the Florida Legislature and the past ten years on the Seminole County Commission.

Additionally, Commissioner Constantine's passion for community service has been well known as the Founder of Charity Challenge, Inc. From 1987 to 2021, Charity Challenge engaged with the hospitality industry and evolved from a small backyard event into one of the largest independent charity's in Central Florida, by raising over \$7 million for hundreds of Florida charities.
