The Plant Diagnostic Lab provides identification and management solutions for: Plant Disease, Turfgrass Disease, Plant/Weed Species, Insect/Mite Species.

The \$25 dollar fee covers basic diagnostics testing and shipping (fee is subject to change/negotiation if more expensive testing is required).
