Corry J. Shedd serves as Chief of Staff for Naval Surface Warfare Center, Corona Division, where he supports the Commander and Technical Director in leading more than 4,100 Sailors, Navy civilian and contractor personnel in Corona Division's critical mission "to provide transparency to warfighting readiness through data analytics and assessment, engineering the Fleet's Live-Virtual-Constructive training environment, and assuring the accuracy of measurements".

Prior to joining Corona Division as a civilian, Shedd served for 30 years as an active duty and reserve Navy Surface Warfare Officer, retiring in 2018 at the rank of Captain (O6).

His last active duty assignment was as Executive Officer of Corona Division.



During his military career, Shedd served in a wide range of assignments that included leadership tours as Deputy Commander for Naval Special Warfare Operational Support Group; Chief Staff officer at Naval Special Warfare Group ELEVEN; and Chief of Staff for Naval Special Warfare Group THREE. He also completed a number of operational deployments and assignments, including duty in Afghanistan with the NATO International Security Assistance Force missions (ISAF IX and X), and other assignments in Egypt, Korea, Thailand and afloat operations.

As a civilian, Shedd served as President/CEO of Envirologic Associates, Inc., and ELA Consulting Group of Colorado, engineering consulting firms focused on construction project turn-around/recovery, contract dispute resolution and technical litigation support. Shedd has also served as Principal of Operations for Kellogg LLC, a full service construction and engineering management consultancy; and as Chief Geologist for TerraPlus USA, where he supported mineral and resource exploration projects in the U.S., Europe, Africa and South America.

Shedd holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Geology, with Graduate studies in Geology/Geophysics. He has been a registered Professional Geologist in Missouri, Wyoming and Colorado, and member of the Colorado Mining Association, the Association of Environmental Professionals, and the Society of American Military Engineers. He is an avid hiker, backpacker and outdoorsman.
