

Advancing Construction Careers

CHARLOTTE



If you like to know how electric currents make things work, then this is the trade for you. Qualified electricians are always in demand. With your tools and knowledge, you can go practically anywhere in the country.

Earning Potential: According to the BLS, the 2022 national average wage for electricians was \$65,280 salary | \$31.39 hourly. Employment for electricians is expected to grow 9 percent from 2016-2026. (The average growth rate for all occupations is 7 percent.)

In the electrical trade you will learn to:

- · Cut, bend and install metal conduits and wiring
- Hook up electrical appliances
- Install electrical switches and lighting fixtures
- Wire door bells and fire alarms
- Repair power cords and plugs
- Use equipment for testing circuitry
- Safely handle power tools
- · Ensure work is done according to relevant codes

Once you complete training, you have a variety of employment options:

- Apprenticeship program
- · Electrical contractors
- Sub-contractors
- · Maintenance company

Carpentry

If you like working with wood and take pride in seeing mething made with your own hands, then this is the trade for you. Carpenters are needed in all areas of construction and are often employed through the entire construction process. Thus, it is one of the most secure jobs within the industry. Many carpenters like to build and fix their own homes and run their own businesses in addition to working on a crew

Earning Potential: According to the BLS, the 2022 national average wage for carpenters was \$58,210 salary | \$27.99 hourly 1 out of 3 carpenters were self-employed in 2016. Self-employed workers often work in residential construction and may be able to set their own schedule.

In the carpentry trade you will learn to:


- · Frame floors, walls, ceilings and roofs
- · Build concrete forms
- · Apply plywood, roof paper and shingles
- · Build and set cabinets and countertops · Install doors, windows, trim and siding
- · Install floor joists, rafters and trusses
- · Lay wood flooring
- Operate table saws, power drills, routers, joiners, planers and nail guns

Once you complete training, you have a variety of employment options:

- Meet energy usage and testing requirements set forth by the High Efficiency Residential Option (HERO) of NC Energy Code

How to Participate

Southern Energy Management
offers a free rebate analysis to tell
you if your homes are qualifying,
and how much you can expect.

2 Get Verified

Homes must receive a HERS Index Score to participate. Your HERS rater will inspect each home at the insulation stage and at final. Once HERO compliance is confirmed at final, your HERS rater will submit documentation for incentives processing.

Get Paid

You'll receive an incentive check 4-6 weeks after the home is submitted to the program!
