<u>Level</u>	<u>Description</u>
<b>Outstanding</b>	Well written and very organized. Excellent grammar mechanics. Clear and concise statements. Excellent effort and presentation with detail. Demonstrates a thorough understanding of the topic.
<b>Value:</b>	<b>9-10</b>

<u>Level</u>	<u>Description</u>
<b>Good</b>	Writes fairly clear. Good grammar mechanics. Good presentation and organization. Sufficient effort and detail.
<b>Value:</b>	<b>7-8</b>

<u>Level</u>	<u>Description</u>
<b>Fair</b>	Minimal effort. Good grammar mechanics. Fair presentation. Few supporting details.
<b>Value:</b>	<b>6</b>

<u>Level</u>	<u>Description</u>
<b>Poor</b>	Somewhat unclear. Shows little effort. Poor grammar mechanics. Confusing and choppy, incomplete sentences. No organization of thoughts.
<b>Value:</b>	<b>4-5</b>

<u>Level</u>	<u>Description</u>
<b>Very Poor</b>	Lacking effort. Very poor grammar mechanics. Very unclear. Does not address topic. Limited attempt.
<b>Value:</b>	<b>1-3</b>
