PROJECT GOAL

To promote regional career opportunities by leading and encouraging students to explore pathways that meet their skills, interests and abilities

AVAILABLE TO HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

For the past 13 years, the **Bridges Career Academies** & Workplace Connection has hosted the Career Exploration Day, an annual special event offering more than 2,500 high school students from 28 local school districts an unique way to meet business professionals and explore careers.

Due to Covid-19 crowd restrictions, Bridges is prevented from hosting this event in 2021.

Despite this, Bridges is offering students an opportunity to explore the hundreds of careers available to them and to better understand local career options.

Professionalism Expected

Just like attending the in-person event, it is a privilege for students to be afforded this opportunity. Any student NOT conducting themselves in an appropriate and professional manner will have their access to the website blocked and your school will be notified.

GAME RULES

Help teach your students how to navigate this career exploration experience website.

- 1. Students should log in via their unique username and password.
- Click "Game Login" on home page to be taken to a page with rules. Login area is on the TOP RIGHT part of this page.
- · Every student has their own login. It is the student's first and last name with no spaces in between. (Some names will also have initials.) Logins ensure a safe & secure environment and allow activities to be tracked.
- Your entire school has the **SAME password**. (This will be shared in late February.)
- Students should use their own login since points are earned as they explore the site. If a student uses someone else's login, they won't get credit for any of the activities they do.

- Career pages feature relevant career information and videos. as well as career skills activities, **360° photos**, and the opportunity to submit questions in the Ask a Professional forum.

Career Skills Activity

All activities are browser-based. so students won't need to download anything or have any special software. They can explore online lab simulations, interactive skills games and more.



360° photos explore the interiors of regional businesses, complete with video and photo highlights, to share more about their machines or job opportunities.

FYI for Educators: Points, Badges & More!

- Only students will be eligible for the prize drawings, but since you also "log in," you will "earn" digital Career Badges.
- After March 26, all points will be reset to zero, but activity tracking will continue.
- Bridges hopes to offer monthly, industry-specific promotions during the 2021-22 school year, so points will be cleared out prior to any themed activity. More information about these activities will be shared in our back-to-school communications.

Ask A Professional

Students can engage directly with regional professionals by submitting questions and getting direct responses. Some professionals may also be scheduled to be online during the school day. All questions will be answered within 24 hours, so encourage students to check back for an answer.

WIN PRIZES!

During the promotion period of March 5 - March 26, 2021, students will earn points for participating in the website's various Career Skills Activities. Points are accumulated based on different types of activities.



- Students will earn a digital "CAREER BADGE" for every 15 points they accumulate. The digtal badges will appear on the top RIGHT side of a page.
- After 3 career badges are earned, students will be automatically entered into a random drawing for a \$10 gift card. (150 total cards will be given out) They will receive notification of this on screen.
- If a student earns 4 badges, they will be eligible to take a Career Exploration Survey. Students completing the online survey will be entered in a bonus random drawing for \$100 cash!

Prize winners will be drawn randomly on March 29, 2021. Odds of winning are dependent upon how many students become eligible. Only one entry per drawing per student is allowed. Prizes will be delivered to each winner's high school in early April and the high schools will distribute prizes to the students.
