Technical talk on the American Concrete Institute Repair Code

The Alaska Chapter of the American Concrete Institute is proud to present a technical talk on the American Concrete Institute Repair Code. This presentation will introduce the ACI 562-13, "Code Requirements for Evaluation, Repair, and Rehabilitation of Concrete Buildings and Commentary." This is the first U.S. code produced specifically for the repair of reinforced concrete. A new guide document for the code with additional information and project examples that help users interpret the code requirements will also be highlighted.
