Take the Time to Report Jobsite Theft

AGC Member Chugach Electric Association, Inc. has been dealing with the clean-up of two fairly extensive homeless camps on Chugach property adjacent to their Substation at 800 East 94th Ave. in recent days. At one of the camps they discovered quantities of obviously stolen property belonging to contractors or builders. They found tools, brand new fall protection harnesses (bright green in color) copper and aluminum wire (none of which I could identify as Chugach property) and other items. The Anchorage Police Department explained that without reports of stolen property that are active and complete with descriptions of the property they are powerless to do anything. The bottom line is that when wire, tools and other jobsite property disappears, it is important to file and have an active police report on the theft.
