

EMI HAZWOPER Refresher Training Class

Held at the AGC Fairbanks Office Friday, March 16th, 8 AM—4 PM. This class is designed to meet the annual 8 hour Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response refresher training requirements of OSHA's 29 CFR 1910.120. This course reviews potential hazards to health and safety associated with site cleanup and emergency response. Students will also be briefed on state and federal regulatory changes.
