In Memoriam ~ Hard Hat Harold Kerslake

Harold A. Kerslake passed away peacefully on June 2, 2017 at the age of 88. In the 1950s, Harold began his career in the construction industry working for Peter Kiewit Sons Co., which took him through the western U.S. and Canada and landed him back in Fairbanks in 1968. In 1984, Harold accepted the position of general manager of Wilder Construction and was proud to have negotiated an eventual employee buy-out of the company from founder Chuck Wilder.

Throughout his career, he believed strongly in the AGC and was a staunch advocate for its causes. In 1995, Harold was the recipient of an **AGC Hard Hat** award in recognition of his 15-plus years of contribution as a board member, committee chairman, labor agreement negotiator and a trustee of the Operating Engineers Health and Security Trust. Harold was a charismatic charmer whose clever humor and wise advice will be deeply missed by all who had the honor of being a part of his life.
