

Silica Inspection Reporting Form

OSHA has not yet released the compliance directive and their interim enforcement guidance is incomplete. This could result in inconsistent enforcement across regions. If your site has been subjected to an OSHA silica compliance inspection or silica compliance was assessed as part of another OSHA inspection, please consider sharing the details of the inspection with AGC by completing this form (link is external). No identifying information will be collected. AGC will report the findings to OSHA's national office and use it to continue our advocacy efforts on behalf of the regulated community.

Do your job sites generate dust from either concrete, brick, mortar, tile and other similar, naturally occurring or man-made materials?
