Legislative Update!

AGC has formally requested that the Governor add the capital budget to the upcoming special session agenda while simultaneously urging the Legislature to meet prior to the special session to fund the capital budget. We've asked our members to also encourage their elected leaders to prioritize a capital budget, but the gridlock has remained. AGC Board President Cuauhtemoc Rodriquez penned an op-ed that was published in the Anchorage Daily News last weekend: https://www.adn.com/opinions/2019/06/22/are-legislators-serving-the-people/

Last Friday, The Governor signed the FY2020 operating budget with approximately \$400 million in line-item vetoes. With an overall reduction in state spending of \$678 million, the Governor alludes that his actions eliminate nearly 50 percent of the state's deficit this year and he hopes that a "two-year process" will balance the budget without new taxes or a reduction of the traditional Permanent Fund Dividend formula. In his announcement he did not outline the potential impacts these cuts may have, but a small portion of federal funding will be unavailable due to the Medicaid reductions.

Some of the more noteworthy veto's, with statewide impacts, were:

- University of Alaska- additional \$130 million
- Medicaid- additional \$50 million
- Senior Benefits- eliminated
- School Bond Debit Reimbursement- reduced to 50% of original State responsibility
- Public Broadcasting System- vetoed all, except emergency broadcasting
- VPSO funding- vetoed
- Education Funding- Vetoed the FY2021 forward funding
- Positions reductions of 62 full-time, 2 part-time and 4 non-perm

In his press release he mentioned that once the PFD issue is resolved, then they can then begin working on the capital budget. We can only hope that it happens quickly and is completed before the end of July.

Early last week, Legislative leadership announced that they will be holding the second special session in Juneau and Anchorage, defying the Governors call for holding it in Wasilla. There continues to be rumors about individual lawsuits and having legislators escorted to Wasilla by the State Troopers. The next two weeks should be interesting, to say the least.
