AGC of America & Partners Organize Nationwide Campaign to urge all Construction Workers to get the COVID-19

Vaccine

The Associated General Contractors of America and other groups are partnering with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) urging construction workers to get their COVID-19 vaccines as soon as they are able. As part of the campaign, the association will distribute educational <u>materials</u> about the vaccine, as well as a new industry <u>public service announcement</u> urging construction workers to get their shots.

"Construction workers have long looked after the welfare of their colleagues, reminding them to stay safe, wear the right gear and be aware of their surroundings," said Stephen E. Sandherr, the association's chief executive officer. "Getting their shot is another way that workers can protect their colleagues, as well as their loved ones and community members."

## 2021 Construction Safety Week & OSHA Falls Stand-Down

Construction Safety Week, May 3 - 7, is an annual event in which people, companies, and even competitors, work together and celebrate the incredibly hard work by people in our industry who make safety the foundation of everything they do. The OSHA National Safety Stand-Down to Prevent Falls in Construction, held during the same week, raises fall hazard awareness across the country in an effort to stop fall fatalities and injuries. The greatest threat to union and open-shop construction—the PRO Act—is one congressional vote away from becoming law. The bill would create conditions where unions hold virtually all the leverage in collective bargaining with union firms and in efforts to unionize open-shop firms. At the same time, the measure would force employers to divulge private information about their employees, denies workers the right to a secret ballot and would unleash an unprecedented wave of labor unrest. 
