## Hernando County Business Alliance Ten-Year Advocacy Plan October 2019

## 1. EDUCATION:

- A. Support the improved technical, vocational, and construction trade skills needed for upcoming employment demands, including Technical schools and courses.
- B. Support an incubator program to meet current needs within the County.
- C. Create a Business Resource website for Hernando Enterprise Network that will work with Career Source for possible funding.
- 2. TRANSPORTATION Transportation projects to be supported:
  - A. Support the expansion of Barclay Ave as a major north/south highway from SR 50 to County Line Road.
  - B. Support widening and improving State Road 50 between I-75 and Clermont.
  - C. Creating an Industrial & Rail Hub project in East Hernando County, including making provision for it in future land planning.
  - D. Support the TBARTA plan to link the Suncoast Parkway at SR 44 exit in Citrus County to a yet unnamed extension of the Parkway as a toll road to the Florida Georgia line.
  - E. Support creating another major East/West highway utilizing Ayers Road/ Hayman Road/ Church Road to connect to I-75.
  - F. Support the re-alignment of US 98 and 41 around downtown Brooksville.
  - G. Support the continued widening of County Line Road from US 19 to the Suncoast Parkway.
- 3. AIRPORT TECHNOLOGY CENTER We support growing the Brooksville/Tampa Bay Regional Airport and Technology Center to a "large" commercial airport and Technology Center with the appropriate rail capacity.

## 4. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND ADVOCACY COMMUNICATION:

- A. Increase the economic development effort and necessary funding to be competitive with other counties of our size.
- B. Support and advocate for business community involvement in government planning and policy decisions through positive collaboration with the County Administrator, School District Superintendent, SWFWMD Director, the Brooksville City Manager and our Elected Local, State and Federal Officials.
