** Technician registrations must be made online or via the forms sent by the Ohio Trucking Association through email and are due no later than **Friday, April 17, 2026**. Payment is due at the time of registration. No refunds will be given after this date except in extreme circumstances.*

Technician Competition Contestant Certification

All contestants must certify that during the twelve months prior to the 2026 Technician Competition (TechComp):

- ✓ the technician has been continuously employed by their company as a Commercial Vehicle Technician;
- ✓ the technician lives in Ohio or is based at a company with a physical address located in Ohio; and
- ✓ the technician is in good standing within their company OR
- ✓ the competitor is a current student studying to be a diesel technician at an Ohio school or university.

Technicians must wear work-appropriate shirts, long pants, and work shoes meeting acceptable industry safety standards. You will be provided with a t-shirt that you will wear on Saturday, May 16, 2026, during the hands-on station competition.

Companies will complete the 2026 Ohio Trucking Association Technician Competition registration spreadsheet. The company representative of that company will certify at the top of the spreadsheet that the registered technicians meet the above qualifications.

Technicians may only compete in one state competition during the calendar year.

Summary of Contestant Ground Rules and Expectations

Registration & Orientation

All TechComp contestants must report to the Zambezi Room for event registration and orientation on Friday, May 15, 2026, between 12:30PM and 1:00PM. Failure to register or attend orientation will result in disqualification, unless the reason for absence given from a company representative is deemed acceptable by the majority of the Ohio Trucking Association or TechComp Steering Committee. If the technician in question is from a Steering Committee Member's company, a different company representative must plead the driver's case if available.

Written Exam

All TechComp contestants will be required to complete their written exam on Friday, May 15, 2026 at 1:00PM.

Stations

Stations will be completed on Saturday, May 16, 2026. A final agenda will be sent out before the event.

If a contestant has a concern or problem, it is to be reported to their station chair, a judge, or an Ohio Trucking Association staff member. These individuals will be marked as such on their name badges. These individuals will then notify the TechComp chairman and/or the committee if necessary.

Only a station chair, TechComp Committee member or OTA staff member can release technicians to leave a designated area.

Meals

Please be advised that all technicians receive breakfast and lunch on Saturday. No meals are provided on Friday.

Audience

Spectators, including families and technicians (when not competing) are welcome to enjoy the Kalahari Resort during their free time. *Please note that family members are not permitted in the competition areas or restricted areas unless escorted by a committee or staff member, and only in the event of an emergency.*

Safety Protocols

If you have tested positive for COVID-19, are waiting for COVID-19 test results, have COVID-19 symptoms, or if you have had close contact with a person who has tested positive for or who has symptoms of COVID-19, please do not attend the 2026 Ohio Technician Competition.

Code of Conduct

Professionalism is required of all contestants, judges, volunteers, staff, and company and industry representatives. The Code of Conduct must be adhered to at all times.

1. No alcohol is permitted in or around the competition area during the entire event; alcohol must not be consumed at any time during competition days, until the competition is over.
2. Kalahari is a smoke-free area. Smoking is allowed only in designated areas.
3. No abusive or profane language will be tolerated.
4. Respect will be shown to all fellow contestants, judges, and volunteers.
5. No destruction of personal or private property will be tolerated.
6. All contestants and their families are expected to behave responsibly and in a professional manner.
7. Cell phones, smartwatches, headphones, and earbuds are not permitted to be with the technician at any time during the competition (including written test and hands-on challenge). Additionally, competitors are not permitted to wear any hat covering their ears. Volunteers must take calls outside of the competition area.
8. For all situations not addressed in this code, or for more stringent company policy, please see your company official or representative for clarification.

Violation of the Code of Conduct will result in immediate disqualification from this year's event. If a technician has completed any or all of the competition when the violation occurs, the technician's scores will be voided. Company officials will be notified and, depending on the severity of the violation, an individual or company may be denied entry in further TechComp events.

The Contestant Ground Rules and Expectations and the Code of Conduct have been implemented to ensure safety for technicians, their families, and volunteers, as well as fair and equal opportunities for all technicians competing.
