Summer Splash focuses on the summer reading program theme and includes literacy activities, discussions, games, crafts, and more. Groups are divided according to age. Registration is required as space is limited. Sign up soon as these classes fill up fast!

- There will be a **FAMILY FISHING CLINIC** on Saturday, June 10 from 9-12:30pm at Sandy Hollow.
