





The Greenbrier

Lewisburg

The Greenbrier County seat has all the hustle and bustle of a larger city, but without sacrificing its quaint small-town charm. With a rich history, Lewisburg is the most populous town and the center of civic life in the county. Originally dating back to the 1700s, several buildings in Lewisburg appear on the National Register of Historic Places, lending the town an old-world romance. Once voted America's Coolest Small Town, Lewisburg maintains a balance between historic preservation and modern appeal and is the cultural center for many attractions and destinations such as Greenbrier Valley Theatre, the state's official professional theatre, a Carnegie Hall, the North House Museum, and several galleries, boutiques, taprooms, eateries and bed and breakfasts. Lewisburg also serves residents with its big box stores, grocers, and other conveniences, such as its variety of places to stay, all easily accessible from Interstate 64.



A redemption story to overcome effects of the devastating 2016 flood, White Sulphur Springs has developed into a lively, growing community. The town's Main Street is a happening place to be with casual and fine dining, coffee shops and bakeries, beauty salons and even a game cafe. The growth of the spa city is thanks in large part to investors, small business owners, community leaders and residents dedicating their time and resources and moving forward together, not giving up on this beloved town. At 11,000-acres, The Greenbrier is and has been one of the biggest attractions here, as a world-renowned resort historically frequented by everyone from American presidents to Hollywood stars. Today, White Sulphur Springs is bustling with new and exciting businesses finding success throughout the town including the first all ADAaccessible hotel in the world, The Schoolhouse Hotel. Another famous connection to White Sulphur Springs is Barnwood Living, a specialty shop made famous by the reality television series Barnwood Builders, further putting the town on the radar of tourists and visitors from near and far.





Ronceverte

Residents are breathing new life into what was once considered a sleepy little town. That spirit of coming together and working toward a common goal cannot be found anywhere else quite like it is in Ronceverte. Home to popular summertime events and a quaint and diverse main street, Ronceverte's revitalization efforts have made it a year-round destination. Named for the French word for "green briar," Ronceverte was established as a bustling river town during its heyday in the early to mid-1900s; it boasts more than 130 structures on the National Register of Historic Places. With a flurry of new businesses opening downtown, Ronceverte is a plucky town with an eclectic, artsy vibe. Situated on the Greenbrier River, Island Park is a community staple home to ballfields and playgrounds, a dog park, Skyline Bluegrass Festival, Ronceverte River Festival, and the beloved Great Rubber Ducky Race.







Alderson

Alderson boasts a fun and funky history, thanks in part to a Federal Prison Camp and its Fourth of July Festival, the largest in the state of West Virginia. Alderson celebrates the nation's independence with an unmatched fervor—the weeklong festivities include a parade, concerts, canoe races and spectacular firework displays. Alderson's Main Street is lined with elegant and historic homes overlooking the rolling Greenbrier River, a picturesque pedestrian footbridge, and a restored railroad depot now operating as a museum. The town's largest employer is the minimum-security women's Federal Prison Camp which has made local and regional headlines over the years for some of its famous inmates including Billie Holliday, Tokyo Rose, Squeaky Fromme and Martha Stewart.

Rainelle

History is a defining feature of Rainelle, located on the west end of Greenbrier County. With a population of 1,500 residents and home of the Meadow River Valley Association, which works to strengthen the region's economies and communities, Rainelle was historically a lumber town. One of its must sees is the 110-year-old Rainelle United Methodist Church, the largest known structure to be built entirely out of American chestnut, an endangered species of tree. Residents enjoy the Rainelle Public Swimming Pool in the summer months and treats from the Fruits of Labor Café and Bakery year-round.




Rupert

Small but mighty, Rupert is part of a larger success story in the region. A small municipality in the western part of Greenbrier County, Rupert has a population of approximately 940 residents. Established in the early 19th century and named after physician Cyrus Rupert, the town's longtime industries are coal and timber. The newly renovated Meadow River Valley Community Center includes an early childhood development center, recreational facilities, a business incubation space and more. The internationally acclaimed painter Max Hayslette was born in Rupert.

Renick

One of the oldest settlements in the county, scenic beauty and farmland of Renick, also known as Falling Spring, is located in northern Greenbrier County. An agricultural community since it was settled in the 1700s, Renick's characteristic rolling farmland offers some of the most breathtaking scenery in the entire county. The William Renick Farm, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, is a twostory limestone homestead built around 1790. The White Oak Berry Farm allows visitors to pick sun-sweetened blueberries by the pound each summer.



reenbrier County Schools: The Greenbrier CountySchoolDistrict serves approximately 5,000 students from pre-kindergarten through 12th grade, spread across nine elementary schools, two middle schools, and two high schools and maintains an impressive student-teacher ratio of 13:2, surpassing the national average of 16:1. The comprehensive educational approach of Greenbrier County Schools (GCS) provides a diverse and well-rounded curriculum addressing students' academic, social and developmental needs. GCS has cultivated over 100 schoolbusiness partnerships, creating a collaborative environment that enhances educational capacity and facilitates real-world connections, bridging the gap between the classroom and the work world. GCS's commitment to building these connections extends to acclaimed Career and Technical Education (CTE) initiatives, offering students outstanding experiential and workbased learning opportunities, and partnerships with local art organizations such as Greenbrier Valley Theatre and Carnegie Hall, enriching the arts learning experience for students across all grade levels. Students make frequent visits to these institutions throughout their educational careers to experience live theatre and musical performances first-hand. Additionally, every fourth grader in the county participates in Link Up, a collaboration with The Weill Music Institute of Carnegie Hall, providing a year-long music-focused curriculum culminating in a concert with students playing recorders alongside a live symphony orchestra. GCS's music programs are among the best in the state, garnering significant accolades.

Communities in Schools, a national dropout prevention program connecting educators and students with local talent and resources from the business community, has a robust presence with site coordinators at all elementary, middle and high schools. Rainelle Medical Center partners with GCS to provide students with individual, group and family counseling, crisis prevention, mental health screenings and other medical services, like sports physicals and acute care.

GCS offers diverse learning opportunities that prepare students for post-secondary education such as its partnership with New River Community and Technical College where high school students can access college-level courses and other certification-based instruction to prepare them for future careers and opportunities. Students also enjoy access to various extracurricular activities, including strong sports programs, clubs, and student government.



Prioritizing student safety, health, and support services, GCS has dedicated school counseling and nursing services in each school and collaborates with local agencies to provide school-based health and various support services to meet student needs. Prevention Resource Officers in middle and high schools play a vital role in school safety, and community law enforcement officers have a presence in all elementary schools. With a voter-approved 60% school levy, the community's support for the school system is evident. This support boosts the school's finances, strengthens educational efforts, and fosters close ties within the community, creating an environment where students can thrive.

Private Schools

Faith-based school programs include Greenbrier Valley Academy, Lewisburg Baptist Academy, and Seneca Trail Christian Academy. For a research-based, non-graded curriculum for pre-K through 5th grade students, there is Greenbrier Community School. Its building is the former Bolling School, the historic school for African American students who lived in Lewisburg during the Jim Crow era of segregation.

West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine

West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine (WVSOM) is ranked first in the nation among all medical schools graduating physicians who practice in rural areas. WVSOM has also been ranked one of the nation's top medical schools for rural health for more than 20 consecutive years by U.S. News and World Report. With more than 800 students and nearly 300 fulltime employees, the school's positive impact on the community is significant and deeply felt. The Clinical Evaluation Center is one of the physician curriculum's unique features in which student doctors work with human patient simulators and standardized patients to develop hands-on clinical and diagnostic skills. Through a partnership with the Center for Rural and Community Health, WVSOM has also established the Clingman Center for Community Engagement to cultivate community learning opportunities, including






a shared-use teaching kitchen where families, youth and those living with chronic health conditions can learn healthy food preparation.


New River Community and Technical College

For a comprehensive higher education at or closer to home, residents often choose New River Community and Technical College (NRCTC), accredited by the Higher Learning Commission. Serving students in nine counties with a Greenbrier Valley campus located in Lewisburg, NRCTC allows students to receive access to an affordable and wellrounded education and workforce programs. Degrees and certificates include: allied health, business administration, computer science, diesel service technology, esthetics, hospitality and tourism management, and other skilled trades. NRCTC makes higher education opportunities and career training more easily accessible to many students.

Libraries

Those time-honored centers of free learning, libraries have and continue to be crucial to our society's well-being. The Greenbrier Valley is home to seven libraries in Alderson, Lewisburg, Ronceverte, Rainelle. Rupert, Quinwood and White Sulphur Springs. Six of our libraries are members of the prestigious Mountain Library Network, which allows community members to access a wider range of materials through interlibrary loans. With an abundance of books and other physical resources, these libraries also provide research assistance, internet access, photocopying, meeting spaces and youth programs.







aintaining one's health and having trusted healthcare facilities and providers for times of need is crucial in every community. With various healthcare centers and many experts in rural health, the Greenbrier Valley has got you covered. The healthcare available here is more advanced than one might expect from our small slice of Appalachia, but residents have been receiving quality care here all their lives and the valley only continues to address their health-related needs and concerns. Home to one of the nation's preeminent osteopathic medical schools training the next generation of professionals, residents also have access to a regional hospital, urgent care clinics and numerous private practices and specialties, in addition to mental health services, home health services, nursing homes and assisted living facilities, HospiceCare and several alternative medicine practitioners.

CAMC Greenbrier Valley Medical Center

This community hospital offers emergency services, surgery and diagnostic services in Ronceverte. The Greenbrier Valley Medical Center (GVMC) and Greenbrier Physicians are now part of the Charleston Area Medical Center (CAMC) Vandalia Health System. Providers in family medicine, pediatrics, orthopedics, and more can be found at the facility, while GVMC also boasts122-beds in a hospital that also serves as a partner for West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine. With nearly 160 physicians and other healthcare professionals on staff, this is one of the largest employers in Greenbrier County. An active community partner offering many educational programs and charity events, GVMC was named among the Top 100 Rural and Community Hospitals by The Chartis Center for Rural Health.

Robert C. Byrd Clinic

Robert C. Byrd Clinic is headquartered on the campus of the West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine (WVSOM) in historic Lewisburg, West Virginia. As a non-profit Rural Health Clinic, RCBC is committed to providing outstanding, comprehensive primary care to families across the Greenbrier Valley, western Virginia and beyond. With a staunch commitment to quality, RCBC is accredited by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) as a Patient-Centered Medical Home - Level 3. The Clinic serves as a practice and research site for WVSOM faculty and offers clinical training opportunities for future osteopathic physicians. RCBC hosts residency programs in the areas of Family Medicine and Osteopathic Neuromusculoskeletal Medicine (ONMM) in collaboration with the West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine and CAMC Greenbrier Valley Medical Center. To create greater access for patients, RCBC has a satellite clinic in Rupert, WV and a mobile clinic serving rural communities across the region.

The Greenbrier Clinic

Following in the tradition of The Greenbrier resort's history of healing beginning with its natural springs, the Greenbrier Clinic, established in 1948, is located on the resort property and provides diagnostic and prevention services. Open to residents as well as resort guests, The Greenbrier Clinic offers a full suite of diagnostic technologies including CT, ultrasound, general radiology, mammography, lab testing, nuclear cardiac imagining, bone density scans, coronary calcium scoring, colonoscopy and upper endoscopy, all in a luxury resort setting.

Rainelle Medical Center

Providing primary care across four West Virginia counties, Rainelle Medical Center (RMC) is the only facility offering mammography services for uninsured women; it also has the only Black Lunch program in the region. RMC partners with Greenbrier County Schools to provide full-time mental health services to middle and high school students. RMC has locations in Alderson, Lewisburg, Maxwelton, Rainelle and White Sulphur Springs offering primary care, pediatrics, diagnostics, pharmacy, dental, counseling and outreach programs for high-risk women and children.

Greenbrier County VA Clinic

Operated by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, the Greenbrier County VA Clinic is located in Ronceverte and provides outpatient care for veterans living in the county and surrounding areas. The clinic also offers services in family and internal medicine as well as mental health care.









MedExpress Urgent Care

This neighborhood medical center, located in Lewisburg, offers walk-in care for minor injuries and illnesses not requiring an emergency room visit. Open seven days a week from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., MedExpress Urgent Care also provides common employer health services like DOT physical exams and school-related physicals.

Dental and Orthodontic Care

Several dentistry and orthodontic practices call the Greenbrier Valley home, and residents have access to pediatric and family dentistry, orthodontics and more to promote and ensure their dental health and put their best smile forward.

Nursing Homes and Assisted Living

People of all ages call the Greenbrier Valley home, and the option of short- and long-term transitional care, independent living, assisted living and respite care facilities allows seniors to live with dignity while avoiding costly hospital trips. These facilities ensure the best for all their patients with utmost care, social connections and more to keep them healthy and happy.

Peyton Hospice House

For special care in special times of need, Lewisburg's Peyton Hospice House, an eightbed facility, treats patients facing serious disease, illness and end-of-life transition with round-theclock care. Peyton Hospice House also offers counseling, spiritual support for the bereaved and plenty of space for families and children. Caring and experienced staff ensure patients are made as comfortable as possible.

Fitness Centers

Greenbrier Valley Fitness, with two locations in Lewisburg, provides residents with premier facilities, equipment and experienced trainers, and its services include weightlifting, conditioning, yoga, Zumba, HIIT, cycling, racquetball, Silver Sneakers, personal training, CrossFit and gymnastics. Additionally, for those looking for something a little different, many martial arts gyms are open throughout the region offering training in mixed martial arts and Jiu Jitsu.

To maintain this delicate balance, we rely on principled organizations, legislative action and community efforts to support sustainable and forward-thinking practices. In this way, we strive to ensure the valley and the state are economically stable for future generations. Tourism, education, agriculture and manufacturing are the pillars of our economic livelihood. The Greenbrier Valley Economic Development Corporation and Greater Greenbrier Chamber of Commerce work diligently together to provide local businesses with financial assistance, networking opportunities and marketing resources. Similarly, the Greenbrier County Convention and Visitors Bureau ensures tourists and would-be visitors know about all the excitement to be found here. We are West Virginia's crown jewel, but maintaining our remarkable slice of Almost Heaven requires hard work, collaboration and smart innovation—and we are prepared to roll up our sleeves and get down to business.

Tourism

Tourism is growing all over the state, and where better than Greenbrier Valley which already has established a rich history and dependence upon tourism for its continued growth? Outdoor recreation and tourism have seen a boom recently thanks to the COVID-19 pandemic encouraging folks to spend more time outdoors, taking in the beautiful sights, and spending more time in nature. The Greenbrier Resort has been a world-famous destination for more than 200 years and continues to enthrall guests. Lewisburg's 2011 designation as America's Coolest Small Town by *Budget Travel Magazine* solidified its tourism credentials. It's not just the mountains, valleys, rivers and streams that bring people here, though the 1,700,000acre Monongahela National Forest, which surrounds the Greenbrier Valley to the north and east, the Greenbrier River Trail, Greenbrier State Forest, numerous parks, trail systems for biking and hiking, public water access and more all hold appeal. With the state itself growing its tourism market share, the Greenbrier Valley is also reaping the benefits. We stand poised to welcome the next generation of visitors and residents who will fall in love with Wild and Wonderful West Virginia.









Agriculture

Agriculture and farming have been economic staples of the Greenbrier Valley ever since our towns and settlements were established. Not much has changed with our strong agricultural economy. Today, farm-to-table dinners are increasing in popularity here, expanding into partnerships with local restaurants and eateries to enjoy the fruits of our labor. The second largest county in the state at 1,021 square miles, Greenbrier County boasts more than 750 working farms raising beef, dairy, turkey and sheep, and remains West Virginia's largest beef producer. Healthy Future Farms of America programs, farm business support, training organizations such as Sprouting Farms and Turnrow Appalachian Farm Collective, local food initiatives and farmer's markets, as well as the State Fair of West Virginia's devotion to the Mountain State's farms and farming culture, all ensure a strong future for agricultural economy here in the Greenbrier Valley.

Manufacturing

Several large-scale manufacturing facilities operate within the Greenbrier Valley. Collins Aerospace Systems, located in Union, is a leader in technologically advanced and intelligent solutions for the global aerospace and defense industry. Specializing in quality and process control for the global textile industry for more than 60 years, Lewisburg's Appalachian Electronic Instruments and Greenbrier Technical Services have designed, manufactured and repaired industrial electronics for more than 30 years. Switching gears a bit, the Greenbrier Valley has been making a name for itself in another industry, quickly becoming a leader in the global beverage market. Both located in Maxwelton, Smooth Ambler Spirits is an award-winning whiskey producer, and Greenbrier Valley Brewing brews craft beers inspired by West Virginia's lore and landscape. Just outside Lewisburg, Hawk Knob Cidery uses Appalachian ingredients to bottle hard ciders and meads. The West Virginia Great Barrel Company is a state-of-the-art cooperage manufacturing whiskey barrels sourced from Appalachian white oak for the global whiskey industry and is also located in White Sulphur. Cheers to this industry!



Communications and Media



ere in the Greenbrier Valley, we are just as serious about our arts, entertainment, and attractions—ways to play—as we are economic development and business growth. Just as diverse as our business community is our arts community, with a range of entertainment experiences. Life here is certainly never dull.

One of only four Carnegie Halls in the world still in continuous use as a performance venue can be found in Lewisburg. Bringing in renowned musical artists from its September to May season, Carnegie Hall has operated as a nonprofit arts and education organization since its revitalization in the 1980s. In the summer months, the Hall presents its Ivy Terrace concert series, while Carnegie Kids College is a twoweek day camp immersing children in dynamic arts and sciences classes.

The Greenbrier Valley Theatre (GVT) is the official professional theatre of West Virginia, with a full production calendar bringing professional actors to town for week-long runs of classic plays, contemporary musicals and everything in between. Each season, GVT also presents the Metropolitan Opera Series Live In HD on the big screen, and the robust youth theatre program has produced more than one professional performer over the years.

Encore Community Arts, formerly Trillium Performing Arts, operates from the historic Lewis Theater in downtown Lewisburg. They produce original dance, theatre and improvisation and offer classes for youth and adults carrying on the tradition of over three decades of performance art.

Creatives can thrive here in the Greenbrier Valley with establishments like Lee Street Studios, an artist collective open to the public where artists maintain studios where they create, display and sell their work, and Gum Store Studios, White Sulphur Springs's newest haven for artists featuring studio space and guest artist collaborations, looking to offer classes, exhibits and other events. The Greenbrier Valley is also home to more professional and working artists than can be listed: musicians, painters, performers, writers, artisans, and more all seem to feel at home and at their most artistic and creative here.

Outdoor Activities

West Virginia is becoming increasingly well-known throughout the U.S. as an outdoor destination, and while statewide there are numerous outdoor activities, there is no need to travel far to experience them first-hand in the Greenbrier Valley, ranging from exertions to enjoyable walks in the park. The 78-mile Greenbrier River Trail offers scenic views of the Greenbrier River where herons and bald eagles fish alongside anglers in kayaks. Operating from the grounds of The Greenbrier Resort, Greenbrier Outfitters offers guided kayak trips down the Greenbrier and New rivers, falconry lessons and more. The Greenbrier Valley Hellbenders Youth Mountain Bike Team, open to 6th through 12th graders, practices and races statewide from July to October, and the Greenbrier Valley Bicycle Club organizes group road rides, advocating for bicycle awareness and safety. Speaking of bikes, Greenbrier Gravel is an amateur gravel and mountain bike team in the county. One of the fastest growing sports and activities in the county, pickleball enthusiasts organize weekend tournaments. For adventurers who prefer a little more instruction and guidance, there are fly fishing guides and off-road driving instructors eager to help, and local hiking groups organizing social hikes to area destinations. Single-track trails crisscross the valley, climbing and descending, leading to little-known swimming holes and rhododendron groves; you never quite know what you might find here. On and off the path, adventure abounds.

Fairs and Festivals

The area has a reputation for its number of festivals and parades. Taking place each August since 1921, Lewisburg has been home to the State Fair of West Virginia, a 10-day celebration of the Mountain State's agricultural traditions with a variety of food offerings, carnival rides and games. With attendance easily topping out around 200,000 people from the state and beyond, it's no wonder concerts always sell out. Also at the State Fair grounds, is the Healing Appalachia concert each September, drawing major music acts like Tyler Childers and Trey Anastasio to the area. Lewisburg's Shanghai Parade each New Year's Day kicks off the year in famously quirky style, and the Lewisburg Chocolate Festival each April brings visitors in to satisfy their sweet tooth. The city also hosts a Martin Luther King Jr. Parade each July. Taste of Our Towns, Carnegie Hall's largest fundraiser, is another

unmatched food festival calling Lewisburg home; the Significant Cinema Film Series also shows films on the lawn of Carnegie Hall for free throughout the summer months. Just west of Lewisburg is home to the ever-popular West Virginia Renaissance Festival, a favorite weekend excursion for families, couples and friend groups. The Ronceverte River Festival marks the start of summer each June, and Alderson's Fourth of July Celebration is bright enough to light up the entire state.

Museums

We here in the Greenbrier Valley are passionate about furthering our education and cultural understanding, as well as learning more about and preserving our history and heritage. The North House Museum and Archive, located in Lewisburg and built in 1820 as the home of James North, houses permanent and temporary exhibitions of local and regional significance, and another of its goals is preserving the Greenbrier Historical Society archives. The museum's latest exhibit, the Frazer's Star Hotel, is a recreated tavern room recollecting the structure's short tenure as a hotel in the 1830s. The Echoes of Slavery in Greenbrier County exhibit recounts the atrocities of slavery that are part of the region's and country's long, painful history, while Conflict and Consequences tells of the Greenbrier Valley's military history. The North House Museum is home to many more impressive self-guided exhibits and displays open to the public.

Accommodations

There's a place to stay for every budget and desire within the Greenbrier Valley. Popular hotel chains, from Hampton Inn, Quality Inn, Holiday Inn Express, Fairfield Inn and Suites, Super 8 and Home 2 Suites, are easily accessible from I-64 in




Lewisburg. With the rise of vacation rentals, such as those available for booking through sites like Airbnb and Vrbo, there are plenty of lodging options in Greenbrier Valley. For a stay with a bit more local flavor and flair, Lewisburg's historic district is home to The General Lewis Inn, a historic inn and restaurant, as well as The Escape, which features stylish suites, and the Thomas Rose Inn and Washington Street Quarters, both with newly remodeled suites. Each of these options are walkable to the town's restaurants and shops. Howard's Creek Inn in White Sulphur Springs provides spacious apartment-style rooms, while The Old Victorian Inn in Alderson, the Inn at Mountain Quest in Pocahontas County and the Creekside Resort and Spa in Monroe County are all unique accommodations. White Sulphur Springs is also home to The Schoolhouse Hotel, a fully ADA accessible hotel with The Varsity Club restaurant and a rooftop bar overlooking the town. Just around the corner is the new Barnwood Village, vacation cabins built by Mark Bowe and the Barnwood Builders team. And then perhaps the most famous and recognizable resort to those within and outside the region, The Greenbrier Resort has welcomed guests to take the waters from the property's healing sulfur spring since 1778. Today, guests can stay in Signature Resort Rooms, Greenbrier Estate Homes or Legacy Cottages-hundreds of choices all bearing the unmistakable panache of the iconic and legendary designer Dorothy Draper. For a more rustic stay, primitive campgrounds and RV campsites are located at certain points along the Greenbrier River and can be found at several parks and recreation sites throughout the region. Additionally, the cabins at the Greenbrier State Forest are a favorite each summer.

Shopping

Many tourists and visitors-and even new and longtime residents-are drawn to the area for its shopping opportunities alone; from antiques to fine art, books, outdoor gear, chic clothing, jewelry and unique gifts, there is something for everyone. On the first Fridays and third Thursdays in Lewisburg and White Sulphur Springs, shops stay open late with complimentary wine tastings, live music and other feature events for a veritable fête each month. The valley is renowned for its creatives, artisans and craftspeople, and you can join us in supporting and revering them by purchasing their work and one-of-a-kind pieces found at shops throughout the area.

Dining

Increasingly known for its dynamic food scene, the Greenbrier Valley has a growing number of impressive restaurants and eateries. From fine dining to farm-to-table fare and comfort food, to a taste of the exotic to more home-grown flavors and Appalachian cuisine, you can find whatever you're craving. The Greenbrier Resort's renowned culinary and pastry apprenticeship programs bring some of the world's most promising chefs here to study and begin their careers-some of whom have stayed to open their own dining establishments. A foodie's paradise, it's no wonder people plan their vacations based around food and satisfy their appetite for this amazing little corner of West Virginia.





he COVID-19 pandemic challenged and changed people's priorities and shifted their mindset to help others as much as possible. Now, when people move to a new area, not only are they seeking employment, housing, services and more, they're also looking for ways to give back, adding a rich level of fulfillment to their lives. Communities were also brought together throughout and because of the pandemic, and neighbors are looking out for one another now more than ever. Working from home also may provide more time for people who wish to fill it in more meaningful ways. The Greater Greenbrier Chamber of Commerce has set aside a portion of the Chamber Guide to provide information on volunteer opportunities; from outdoor volunteer opportunities to assisting kids in schools, helping fellow community members stay warm in the winter months and donating time, money or other necessities, there are ways for everyone to get involved.

Greenbrier River Trail Association

The Greenbrier River Trail has two groups of active volunteers dedicated to promoting, preserving and improving the 78-mile trail located in Greenbrier and Pocahontas counties: The Greenbrier River Trail Association (GRTA) has been in existence for more than 40 years, and in 2020, the Greenbrier River Trail Foundation (GRTF) was formed, which, as a state park foundation, now has access to West Virginia State Park matching grant funds used to expand trail improvement projects. Both nonprofit organizations foster trail health and vitality, working closely with the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. With grant and volunteer opportunities, such as organized work days and annual trail events, GRTA, headquartered in Caldwell, is currently seeking trail supporters and volunteers.

United Way of the Greenbrier Valley

With their focus on education, health and financial stability, United Way of the Greenbrier Valley, headquartered in Lewisburg, works to provide basic needs to local students, financial stability for lower income families and increased access to affordable healthcare in the region. Founded in 1986, United Way of the Greenbrier Valley is always looking for volunteers, those to advocate for good public policy and community input aligning with its goals and focuses. Fundraising is key, and volunteers can also participate in a number of service projects, such as the Lewisburg Chocolate Festival and a Day of Service with the West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine, while United Way of the Greenbrier Valley also collaborates with other community partners and benefits local and regional nonprofits.

Greenbrier County Humane Society

Volunteers can get involved in many ways with the Greenbrier County Humane Society, an animal shelter established in 1965 and incorporated as a nonprofit organization in 1986. The humane society accepts donations and has membership opportunities, planned giving and a wish list that those interested may purchase from directly. The Greenbrier County Humane Society coordinates spay/neuter programs, adoptions, animal lost and found and educational programs with area schools. They accept volunteers to both socialize cats and walk dogs, and once volunteers are trained, there is no limit to when and how long they can be at the shelter to benefit the animals there.



Almost Heaven Habitat for Humanity

Habitat for Humanity is a global nonprofit housing organization working with local communities across the U.S. and in approximately 70 countries around the world. Established in 1976 in Americus, GA, Habitat has since grown to serve more than 35 million people through new home construction, rehabilitation and repair programs globally. Almost Heaven Habitat for Humanity works alongside volunteers and future homeowners to build, renovate, and repair homes across southern West Virginia. Their ReStore is located in Lewisburg and all revenue goes into a revolving "Fund for Humanity" to support future build projects in our community.

Wellspring of Greenbrier

Established in 2004, Wellspring of Greenbrier is a faith-based nonprofit organization serving the underprivileged in Greenbrier County, aiming to provide food, clothing and other life essentials to the county's disadvantaged, unhoused and transient populations. Their day haven, located in Rupert and operating on a first come first served basis at no cost, provides a respite with available showers, laundry facilities, light refreshments and a greenhouse providing fresh fruit and vegetables run by volunteers. Wellspring of Greenbrier volunteers also help improve homes for those who are below the poverty line and/or disabled each April through October; in the winter months, they assist in finding heating resources for those in need. They operate a food pantry twice a month, host multiple giveaway events throughout the year for household items, clothing and hygiene and cleaning products, and have an express bread and soup service on the off weeks from the food pantry. During the holidays, Wellspring coordinates with local churches and organizations to sponsor a family in the community with presents and groceries. Volunteers are the backbone of Wellspring.

Communities In Schools of Greenbrier County

Communities In Schools of Greenbrier County (CISGC)'s mission is to empower students to overcome by linking them to available community resources. Located in Lewisburg, CISGC is part of a larger national nonprofit organization network, and during the 2022-2023 school year, more than 4,6000 area students benefitted from programs and services CISGC provided; almost 600 students received individualized case management and 100% graduated or completed the GED, with an 88% rate for improved academic and behavior as well as a 100% improved attendance rate. It serves 13 public schools in Greenbrier County. With donations, volunteers and community partners, CISCC has provided children with food, clothing, housing and utility assistance, enrichment, mentoring, tutoring and more.




