


Inflation is Cooling (slowly)




The Overall Economy is Strong




Job Creation Slowing but Still Strong



U.S. Employment Change by Industry











Missouri's Strong Employment Trend






- Missouri has added over 117,000 jobs since before the pandemic. This ranks 15th nationally.
- For the year ending April, Missouri has added 74,900. Only 8 states have added more.


Missouri US Emp Change by Ind







Employment Change by Industry Comparison

- But it is lagging in professional and business services.







Manufacturing Construction in the U.S.




Why is Professional Business Services particularly important? Higher Earning Jobs

 Average earnings in management of companies and in professional, scientific – technical services jobs tend to be higher.



Why is Professional Business Services particularly important? Bigger contributor to GDP Growth


- As a contributor to overall economic growth (GDP), Professional and Business Services outpaced total GDP growth (36.55% to 14.1%).
- Growth was even higher for Professional, Scientific and Technical Services and for Management of Companies and Enterprises.

Like the state, Metro Kansas City has outpaced the nation in manufacturing, but has lagged in professional-business services




Kansas City's recovery was not as strong as the nation's, but it outperformed in 2022.




KC MSA GDP by County

GDP Growth by County


 Since 2017, Clay County's economy has grown the fastest at 14%.




Kansas City MSA Employment by Industry



Kansas City MSA Employment Concentration and Growth







Clay County Employment by Industry






U.S. Population Forecast

No growth economic development might be delayed, but it will be an issue eventually.






