# Florida Reemployment Assistance (RA) Reference Guide



## How to File:

- By Internet at our website www.nondarabs.org
- By Phone at 1-800-681-8102 Monday through Friday 8 a.m. 5 p.m if affected by one of the following:
  - 1. Physical/Visual Disabilities
  - 2. Illiterate or Language barrier
  - 3. Legally prohibited from using computers

## What you need to file a claim:

- Social Security number (SSN) or Alien registration number and expiration date (if a non-U.S. citizen).
- Driver's License or State ID
- Employment info over the last 18 months:
  - 1. Name, address, phone number
  - 2. Gross earnings
  - 3. Reason of separation

Additionally you may need: work authorization forms, military/federal work documentation, union information.

## **Monetary Requirements:**

- Worked and earned wages totaling \$3400
- Worked and earned wages in two or more calendar quarters during the base period
- The total base period wages have to equal at least 1 and 1/2 times the wages in the high quarter during the base period.

# What you need to do after you file:

- Request benefit payment biweekly
- Complete full registration with Workforce Services
- Provide work search contacts
- Complete fact findings

Once determinations are complete and you begin receiving benefits, you will be mailed a <u>mandatory</u> appointment with your local CareerSource Florida location.

#### Work Search Criteria:

- You must submit 5 work searches per week and include the following:
- Date, Name, Address, Phone Number, Type of work sought, Result, and Method of Contact phone, email, fax, online, etc.
- You may also attend a CareerSource Florida training or workshop in lieu of the 5 contacts.
- If you reside in a county with a population less than 75,000 the work search requirement is 3 per week.
